There are less than two weeks left to apply for the [Earthquake Ready Burnside Bridge's](#) Community Design Advisory Group (CDAG). Multnomah County continues to accept applications from volunteers to join the group through **December 4, 2022**. The CDAG will support the Final Design Phase for the Earthquake Ready Burnside Bridge project by providing the project team feedback on bridge aesthetics, including colors, materials, and lighting, as well as the shape of certain features on the bridge.

The CDAG will meet approximately every-other month for two hours starting in 2023 through 2024.
