I am in favor of appealing the decisions to allow the use of trailers for offices on PWB Filtration Plant and Pipeline sites because the initial permits expired last September therefore those trailers are now there illegally and need to be removed! The fact that they remain is a clear violation of Conditions of Approval for the Land Use permit. Multnomah county is acting irresponsibly by not requiring the Portland Water Bureau to follow the conditions and remove the trailers until other new legally applied for and legally granted permits are in hand. The permits for land use on these two conditional use sites were issued under conditions of approval therefore if the conditions are not upheld then the overall land use permits are null and void. If Multnomah County Land Uses is not responsible enough to investigate and enforce the conditions then Multnomah County Board of Commissioners, which oversees the Zoning and Land Use Department needs to hold them accountable. The Board of Commissioners is elected by the people and therefore has a responsibility to the people to at least adhere to county rules and regulations. If Land Use won't abide and Commissioners don't make the Land Use Department toe the line and do the correct thing then the Commissioners should not be holding Public Office and definitely not be reelected.

IF CONDITIONS ARE NOT MET THEN THERE IS NO ACTIVE PERMIT. Seems pretty simple so please restrain from issuing a new permit until the trailers are stop being used and are removed since they are on site as a violation.
