

rebar (no cap), bent over and 6" below the ground surface.

SURVEY REF #4

The purpose of this survey was to monument the USDA Forest Service ownership, known as the Springdale Administrative Office, as described in Bk2127/Pg556, Bk1319/Pg2003, and Bk1410/Pg322. A closed traverse was run and search was made for all previously monumented corners. Found property corners were held as noted, based on Reference Survey #4, and acceptable positional tolerance. Lost property corners at the Southwest corner, and the two corners at the Southeast corner of the parcel, were re-established by holding the found iron rod at the northwest property corner, and using courses per Deed Record, Bk 2127/Pg 556, and SN44605, closing back into the found iron rod at the PC point on the East line. The Northeast corner position was established at the intersection of the south right-of-way line of Woodard Road, and a line 100 feet northwesterly of and parallel to the centerline of Crown Point Highway, per Deed Record, Bk 1410/Pg 322, and holding the found iron rod, survey ref #4, as on the radial of the PC of Crown Point Hwy.

Field equipment used was a 1" Nikon DTM 730, Total Station with Electric Data Collector. Closed unadjusted traverse exceeded 1:80,000. All corners shown were field visited and/or set in November 14, 2001 and February 8, 2002, as noted.

BASIS OF BEARINGS

The Basis of Bearings is the south Right-of-Way line of Woodard Road, which is parallel to and 30 feet south of the north line of the NE1/4 of section 5, as established between found monuments as shown. The bearing of "WEST" held from SN 44605 (Survey Ref #4).


