THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into by and between GENE SHAFER and JO ANN SHAFER, ELIZABETH HOLM and MATT A. HOLM, MARJORIE L. TABER and LEON D. TABER, MABEL DUDLEY and LEO E. DUDLEY,

WHEREAS, Gene Shafer, Elizabeth Holm, Marjorie L. Taber and Mabel Dudley are the heirs under the Will of ROSE HOWELL, deceased, which said estate has been probated in the Probate Department of the Multnomah County Circuit Court for the State of Oregon; and

WHEREAS, the other parties hereto are the spouses of the said beneficiaries; and

WHEREAS, by the third clause of the Will of Rose Howell, deceased, the beneficiaries under the said Will are requested to make a division of the assets among themselves, if possible to do so; and

WHEREAS, the beneficiaries have been able to agree among themselves how the assets to be received by them under the Will of Rose Howell, deceased, should be distributed.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the covenants hereinafter set forth, it is AGREED between the parties hereto that the assets to be distributed to the beneficiaries under the Will of Rose Howell, deceased, shall be divided and distributed as follows:

1. To GENE SHAFER, the sum of Four Thousand Seven Hundred Ten and 86/100ths Dollars (\$4,710.86).

2. To ELIZABETH HOLM the sum of Fifteen Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety and 44/100ths Dollars (\$15,990.44), and the center one-third of the following described property:
