Dear Hearings Officer:

Following up on the Oct. 8 hearing, Dunn Carney reached out to multiple land surveyors to learn that they are exceptionally busy at present. I spoke by phone with longtime Professional Land Surveyor Tony Weller on Oct. 14. He confirmed my assertion at hearing that surveyors lack any authority to declare a property boundary. Rather, like attorneys, they render nothing more than professional opinion.

Reviewing the DSL website, Mr. Weller noted that the Multnomah Channel is non-navigable and tidal-influenced. He also referred me to specific pages of the BLM's 2009 Manual of Survey Instructions as helpful in determining the subject boundary of Lot 1200.

My paralegal, Tom Holmes, recovered documents referenced above, as well as some others relevant to calculation of the area of Lot 1200. I attach his affidavit of this day, and plan to submit on a later date argument regarding its relevance in this matter.
