I would like to share a few priorities based on feedback from members of the community.

Public Safety– We are still dealing with the effects of eliminating the Fairview Police department and contracting with Multnomah County Sheriff to deal with our day-to-day public safety challenges. This was a decision we are living with when the council was made up of other elected officials including my opponent, Mike Weatherby. My area of focus is to make sure our contract is fulfilled by Multnomah County and improve police presence in the neighborhoods.

I am delighted all the existing sidewalks in the city have finally been evaluated and repaired. This has been a multi-year project that is now complete. This provides a safe use of the public right of way for all of us including our senior and disabled community members.

Financial Health of the City – We have all experienced challenges over the past few years especially since March 2020 when COVID changed how we all did business. I support looking at how we provide services in Fairview. There is opportunity for some synergizing of services between Troutdale and Wood Village. We already contract with Gresham for Fire Services.

Economic Development – I am excited with the opening of the Fairview Food Cart Plaza. This compliments the already established food and beverage locations in Fairview. The Fairview Food Cart Plaza brings in many new business owners and supports diversity in the community.

The continued work improving the Halsey corridor will provide additional funding to support the general fund. This provides amenities for the community while supporting public safety and infrastructure improvements.

I appreciate your continued support while serving on the Fairview City Council.
