Record of Results:

Fairview needs proven, results-focused leadership. As Mayor until 2019, I left the city financially stable with adequate reserves: we paid off our water bond debt, invested \$300,000 each in the Park Cleone and Lake Shore Park projects, \$75,000 to reduce vandalism in Fairview Woods Park, and \$25,000 to restore upstairs access at Heslin House. I also helped bring \$33 million in new tax-paying development to Fairview, combining affordable housing with retail space.

Today the city faces new public safety and budget challenges. With our tax base frozen, Fairview must operate as lean as possible while taxing residents as little as possible. I will carefully evaluate the Gresham Fire and Multnomah County Sheriff's contract renewals and separately review whether a Fire District is affordable for our residents. I support a moratorium on local fees and tax increases wherever feasible, and I will insist on transparent budgeting so residents can see exactly where every dollar goes.

Fairview also needs new retail businesses to grow its tax base without raising taxes on residents. As I did before, I will collaborate with developers to bring tax-paying commercial growth back to the city, targeting vacant and underused sites first.

I am running again because Fairview's finances and safety services deserve the same discipline I brought before. My business background and proven record will help the Council make practical, cost-conscious decisions that protect residents and strengthen our community's future.
