I moved to Fairview in May 2024, and it didn't take long to feel like home - strolling through the park near City Hall, attending SummerFest, or grabbing coffee at Stomping Grounds. This is a city I've come to love, and I want to help be of service to it.

I'm a Licensed Professional Counselor with over five years in mental health, including acute crisis care. My work is aiding people in finding stable ground in hard moments - listening closely, reading a situation honestly, and creating a plan that holds. That's the same approach I want to bring to city government.

Public safety matters deeply to me, and I serve on Fairview's Public Safety Advisory Committee because our residents deserve the best deal on fire and police coverage - real protection, not an

afterthought in a larger regional system. I also serve on the Budget Committee, so I've sat with the actual numbers - I know our margins and how real the choices ahead are.

Three priorities will determine Fairview's next decade: our long-term fire and emergency response structure, a practical local plan for homelessness as county resources dwindle, and a budget that doesn't balance itself without hard, concrete choices.

Local government shouldn't be complicated or distant. Residents should be able to see where the money goes, what Council is deciding, and why.

Outside of city work, I love any excuse to dress up - Halloween is my favorite holiday, and I don't limit myself to one day a year. If you'd like to talk, about any of this or something on your street, I'd welcome the conversation over a cup of coffee. I'd be honored to earn your vote.
