This case came on for hearing on December 13, 2023, on Plaintiffs' Motion for Stay of Judgment Pending Appeal ("Motion"). Plaintiffs appeared through their attorney, Tony L. Aiello, Jr. Defendant appeared through Assistant County Attorney Andrew Weiner.

Plaintiffs have filed in the Oregon Court of Appeals an appeal of the Court's September 19, 2023, Judgment of General Dismissal in this case. That Judgment followed the Court's September 1, 2023, Order granting Defendant's Motion To Dismiss Plaintiffs' Complaint.

Page | 1 - ORDER ON PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR STAY OF JUDGMENT PENDING APPEAL

Plaintiffs now move the Court to stay its judgment, and to enjoin the enforcement of Multnomah County Ordinance 1311 (which Plaintiffs Complaint argued was invalid).

The Court has considered Plaintiffs' Motion pursuant to the factors provided in ORS 19.350. With respect to those factors, the Court finds as follows:

- 1. Plaintiffs' appeal is taken in good faith and not for the purpose of delay.
- 2. Substantial financial harm would befall Plaintiffs were their requested stay denied.
- 3. Plaintiffs have an extremely low likelihood of prevailing on appeal.
- 4. There is very little support in fact or law for Plaintiffs' appeal.

In view of the above factors, Plaintiffs' Motion For Stay of Judgment Pending Appeal is DENIED.
