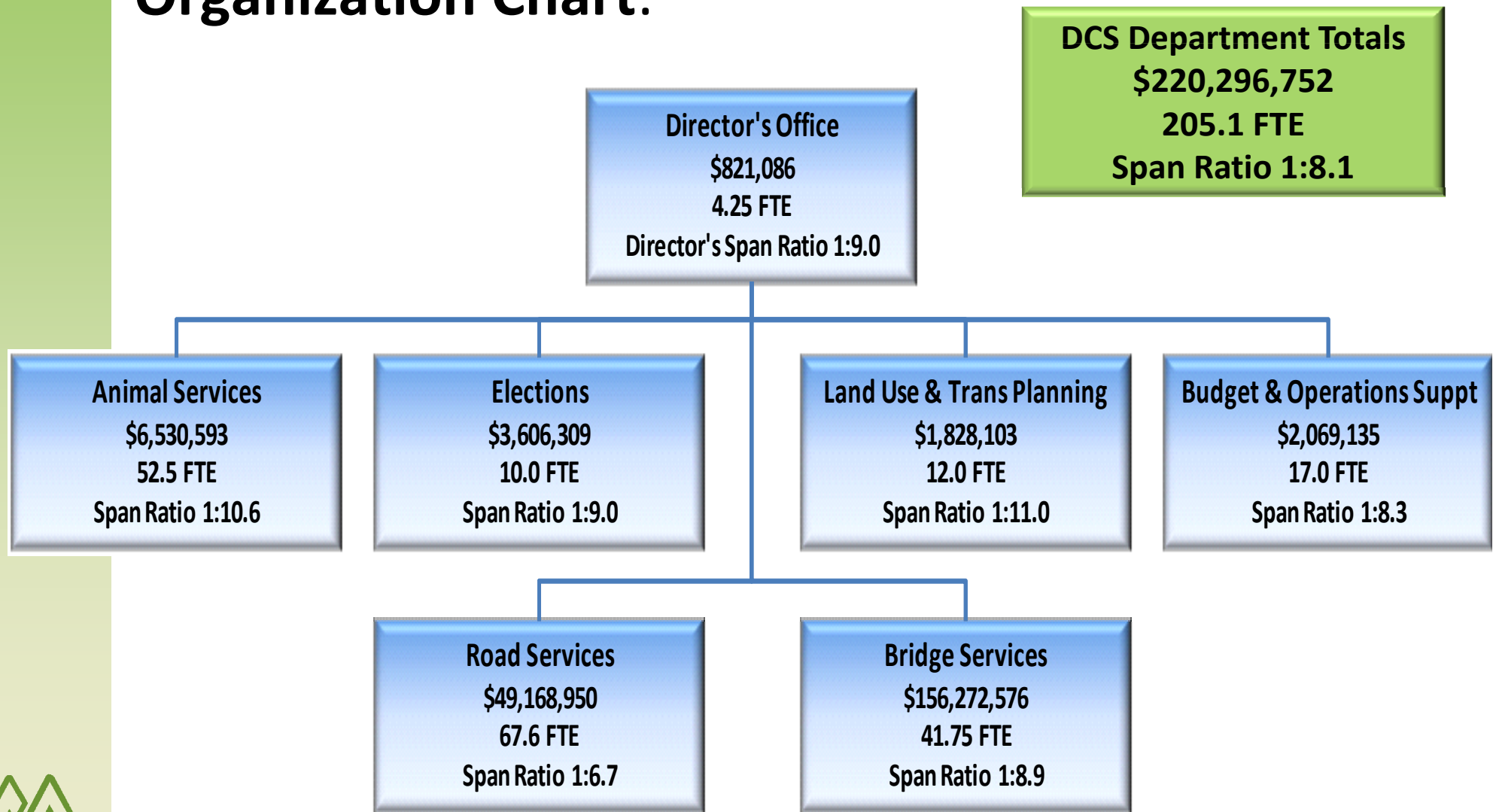

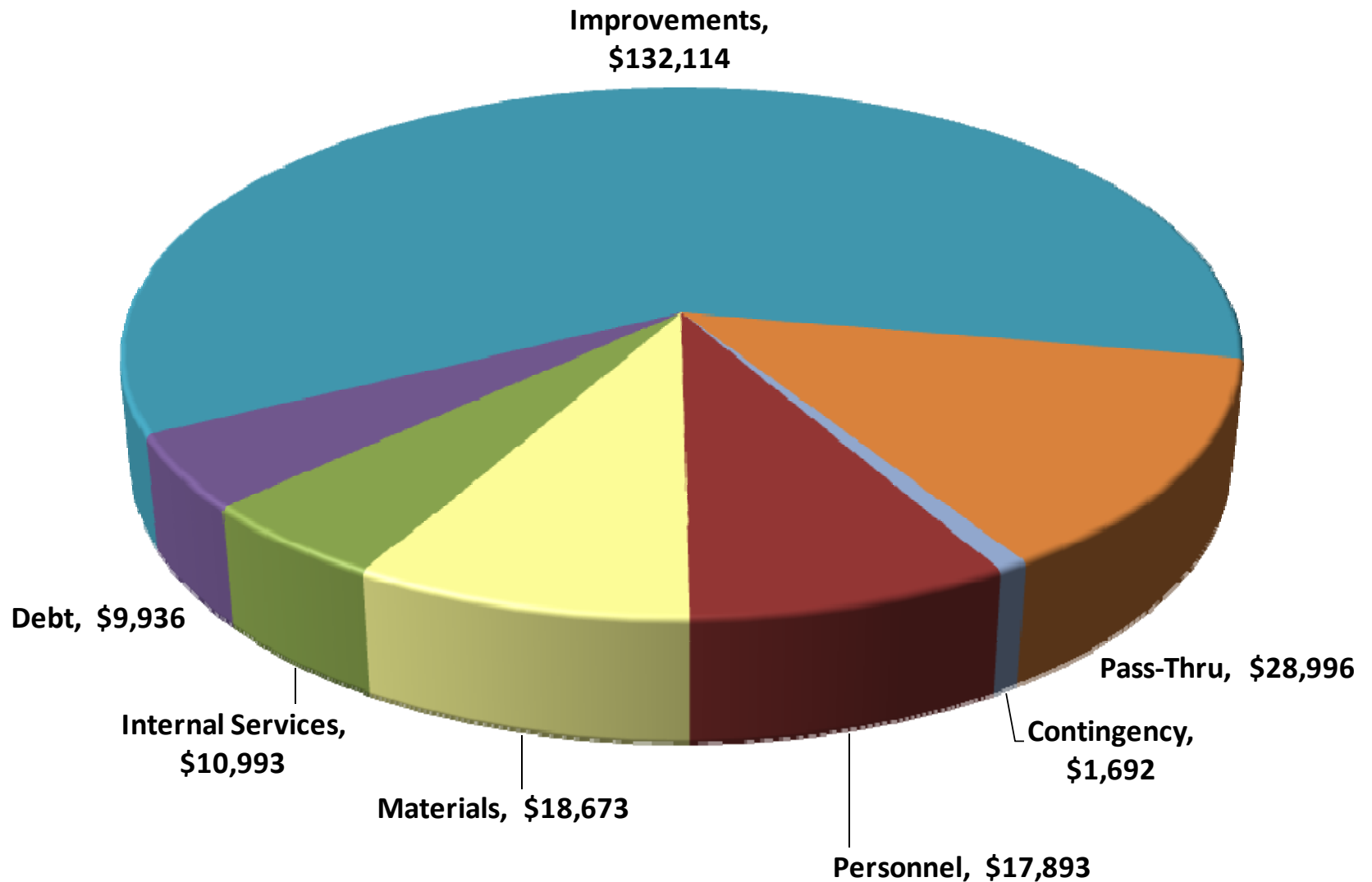

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Budget by Spending Category: Total \$220 Million

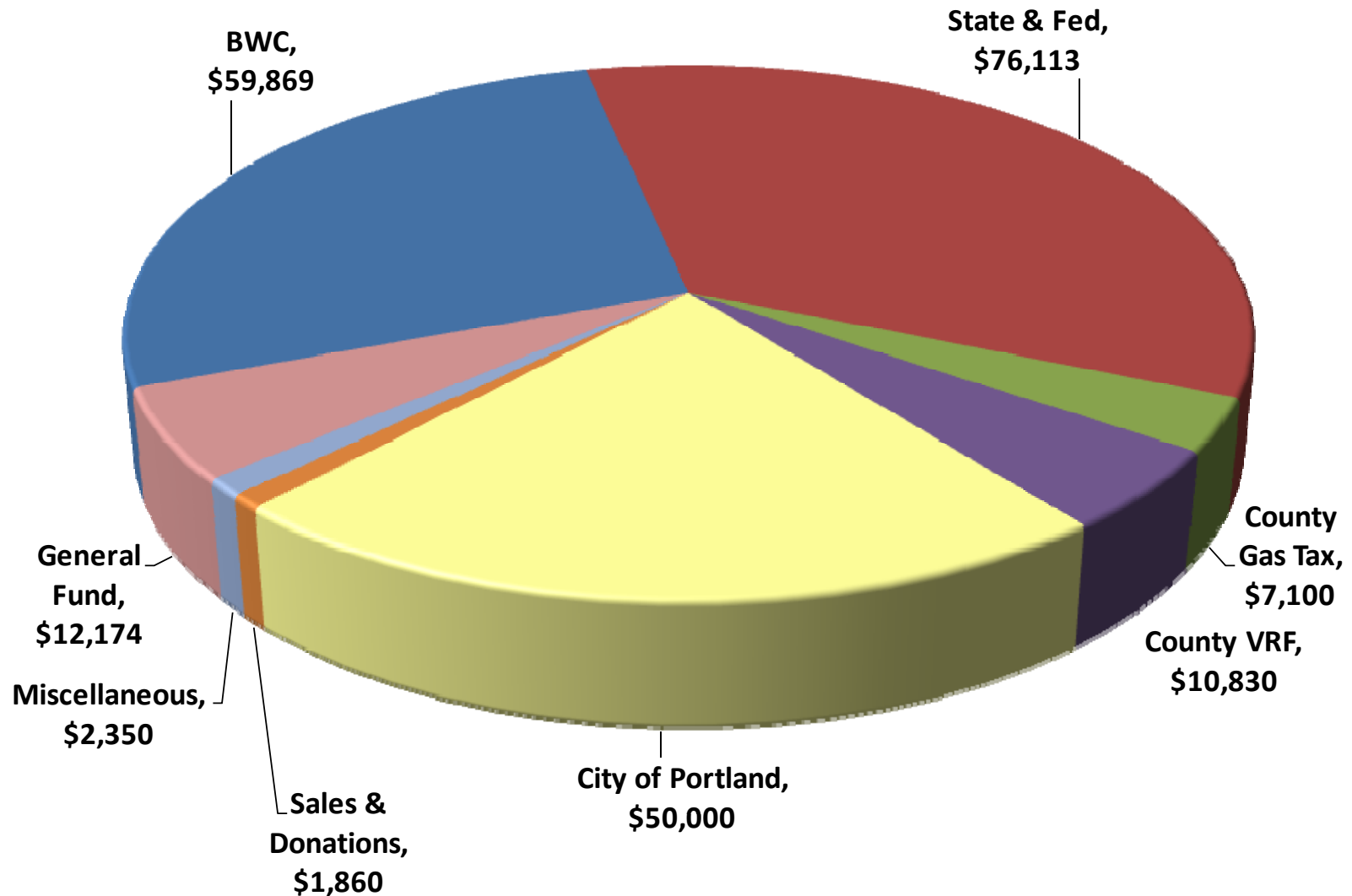


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Budget by Funding Source: Total \$220 Million

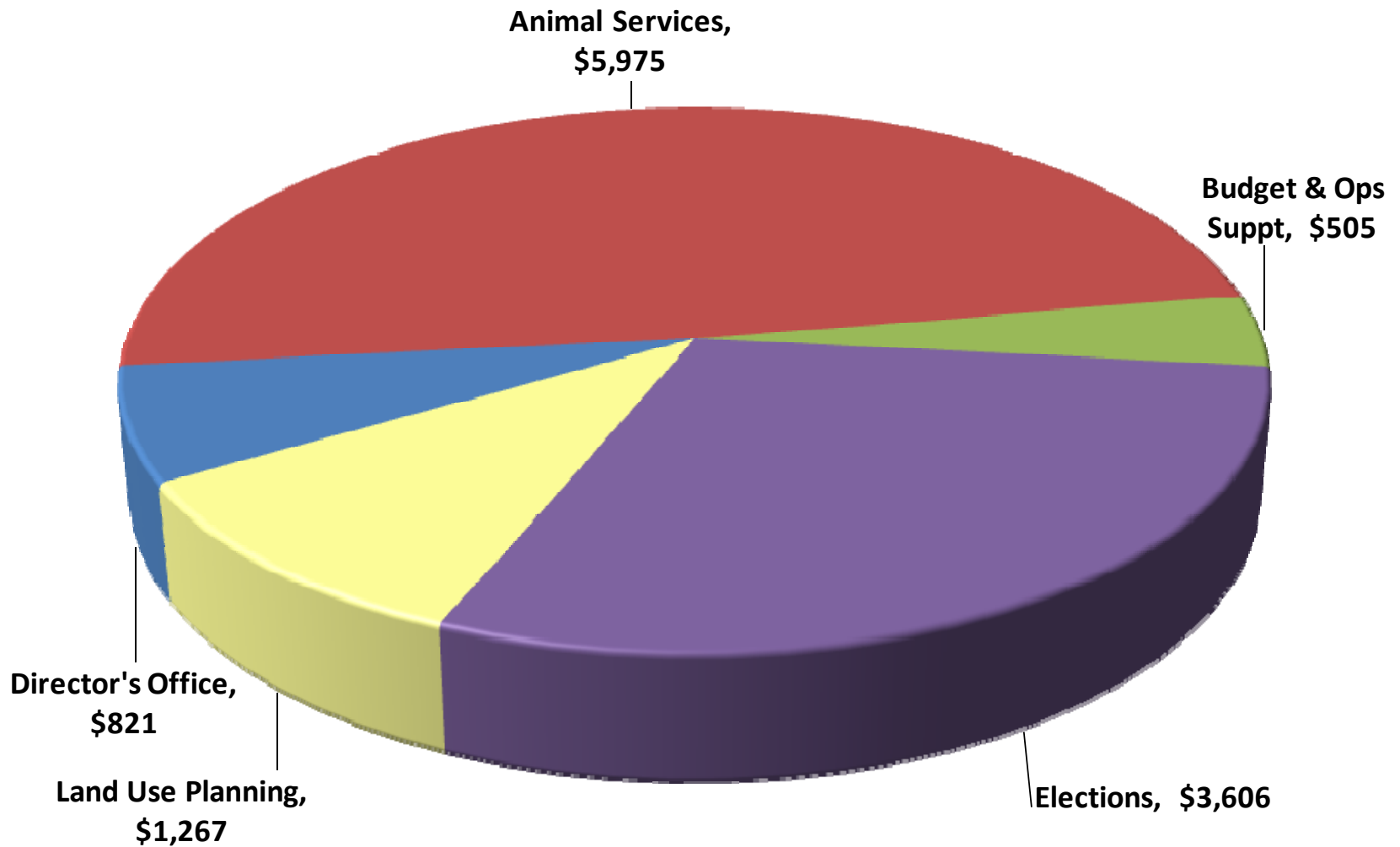

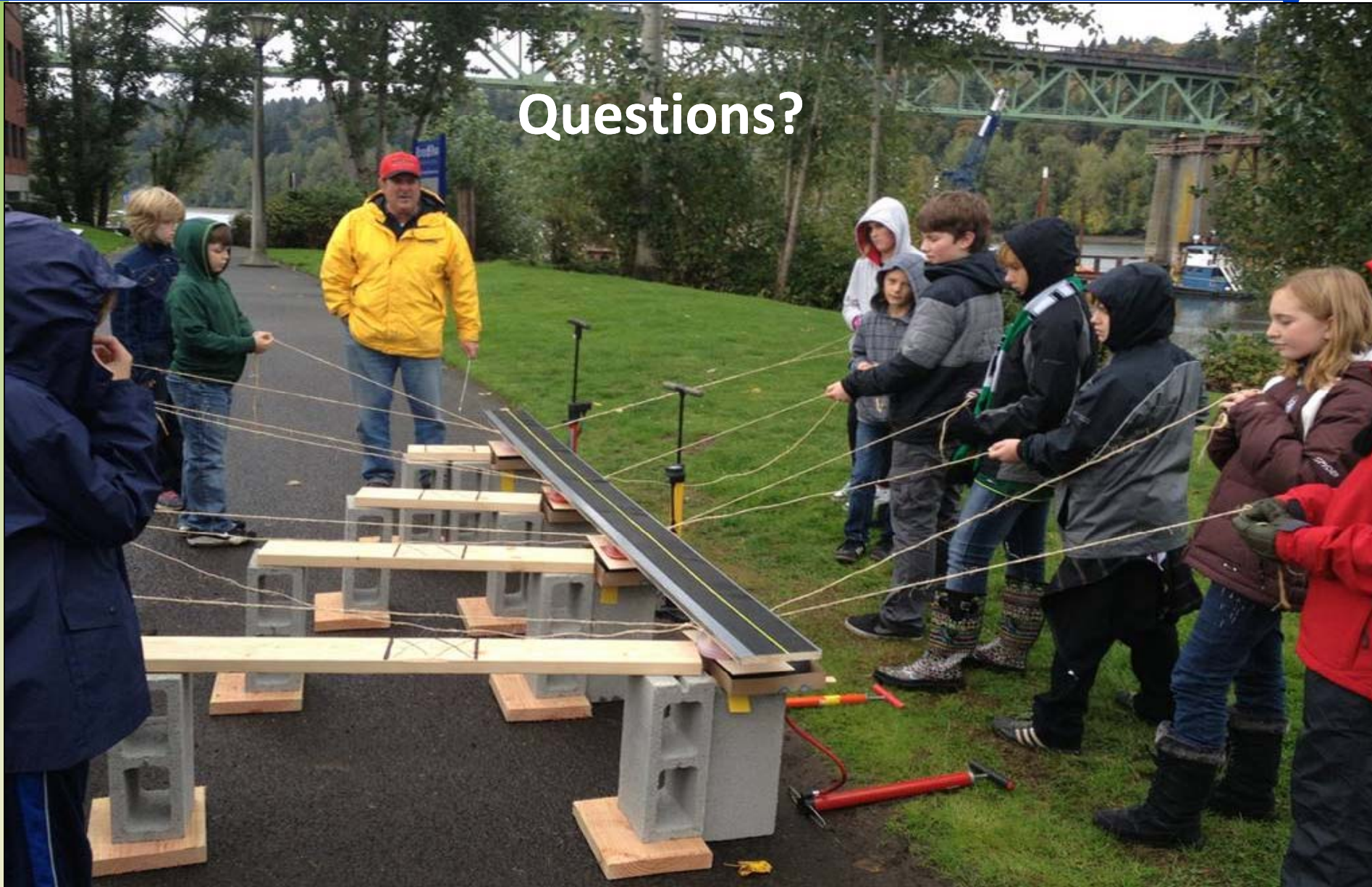
