

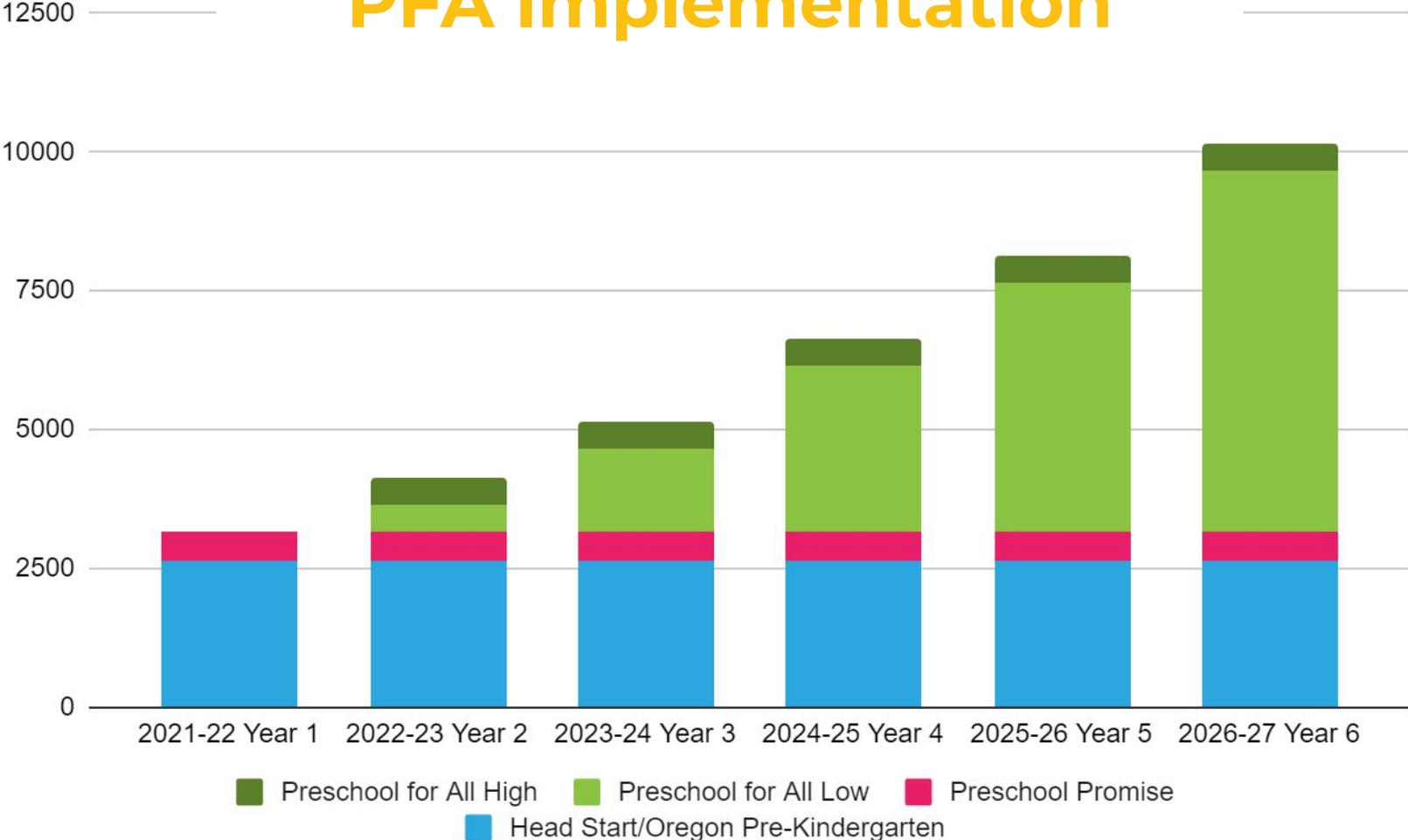

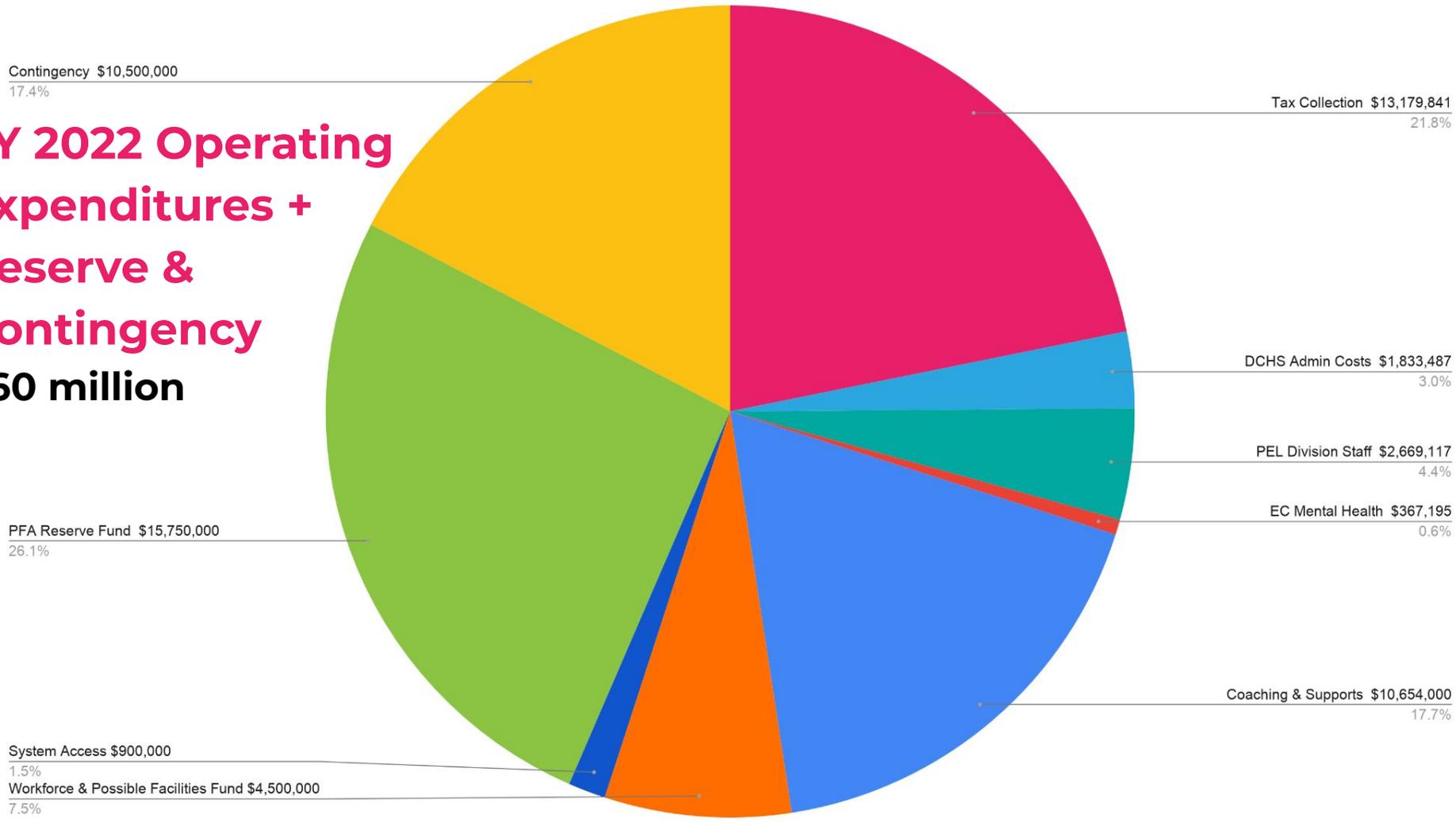

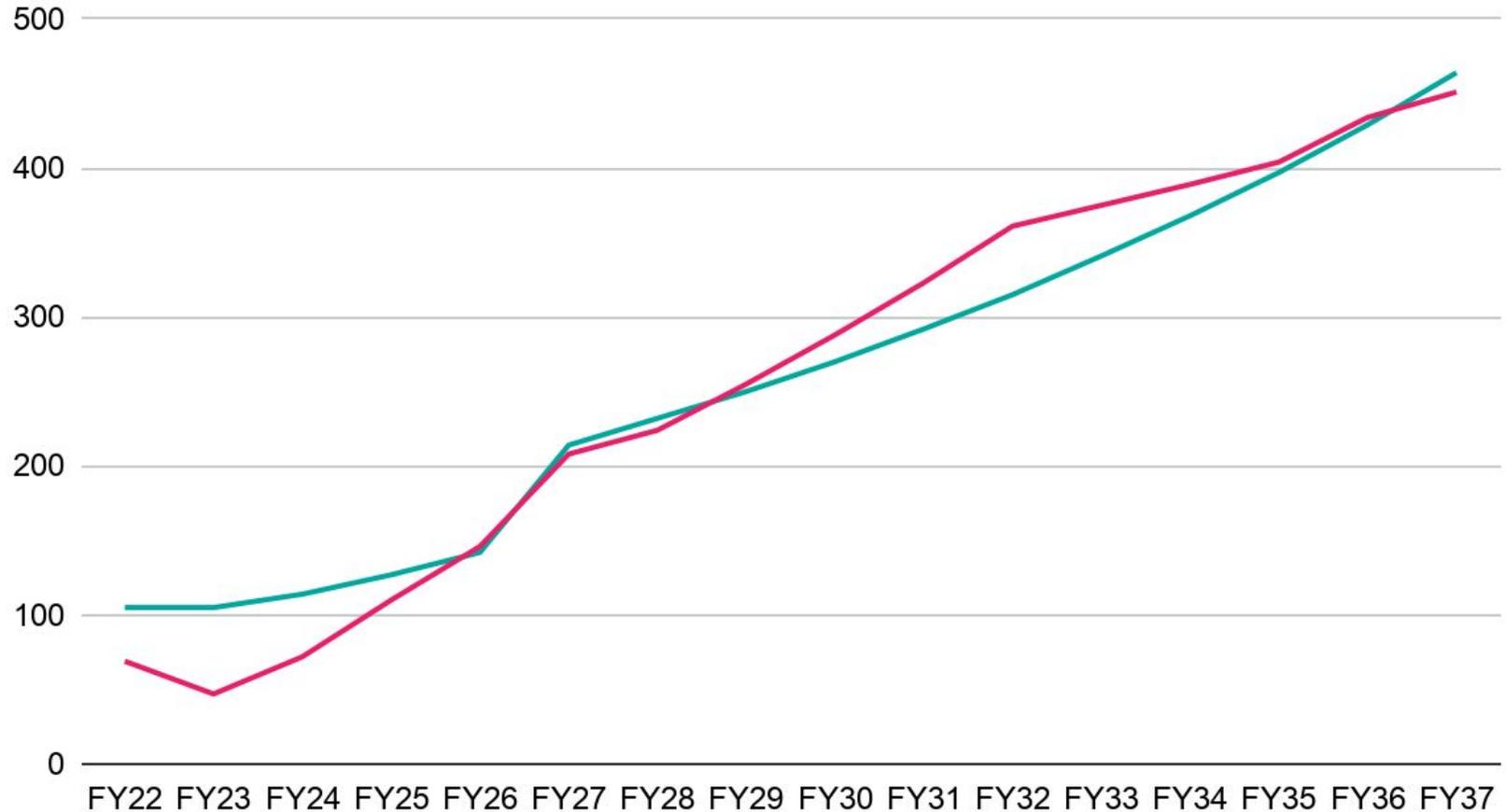


FY 2022 Operating Expenditures + Reserve & Contingency \$60 million



PFA Revenue & Expenditures

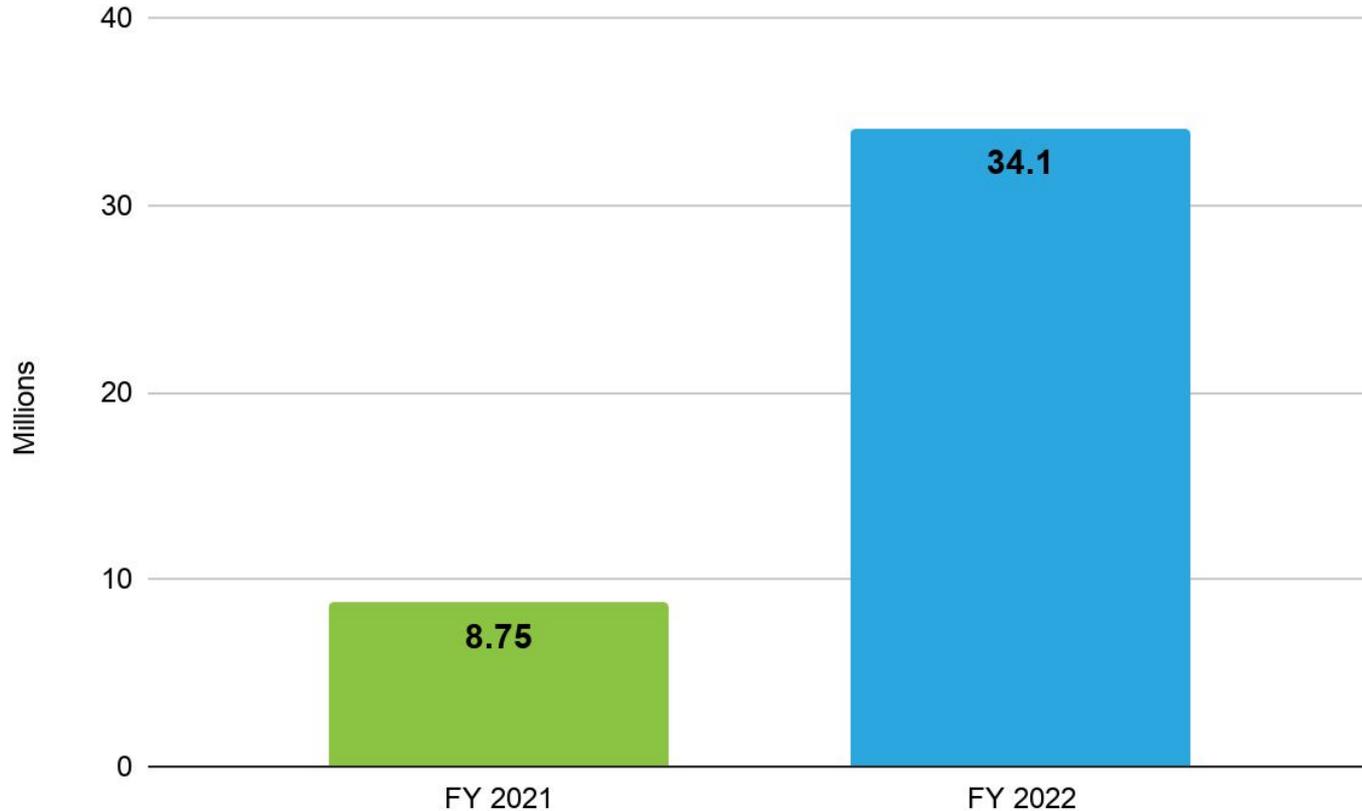
Anticipated Revenue Anticipated Expenditures



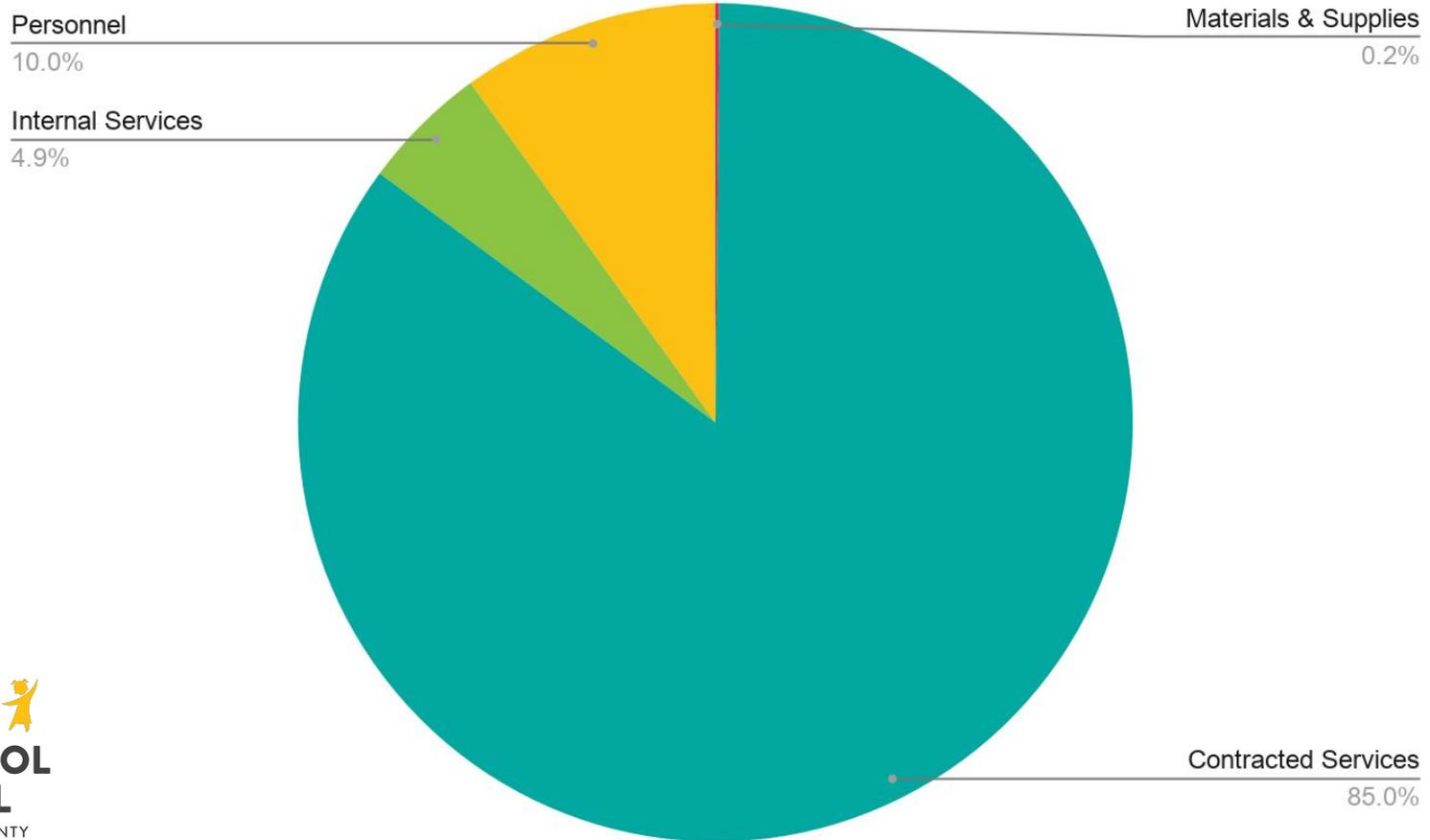

FY 2021 and FY 2022 Anticipated Expenditures

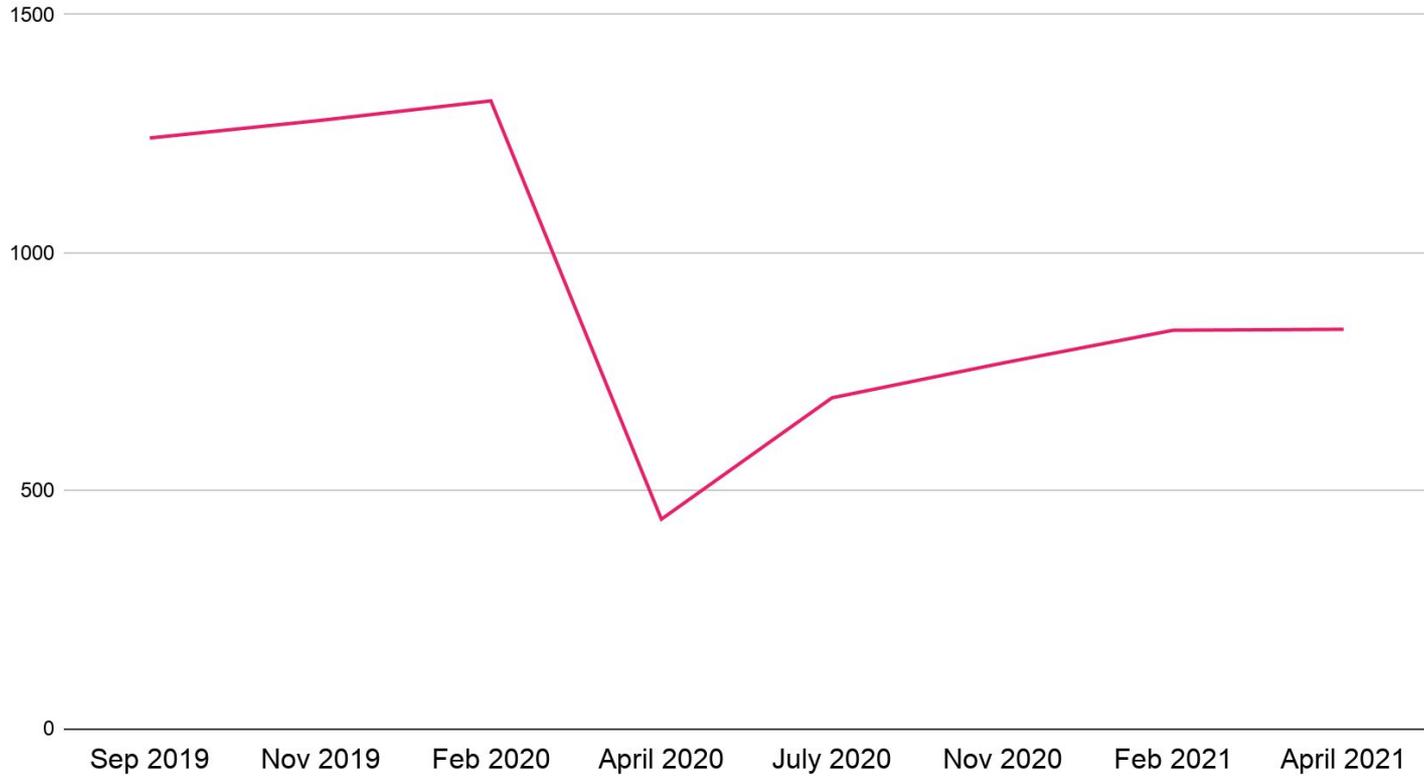


FY 2022 Operating Expenses by Category

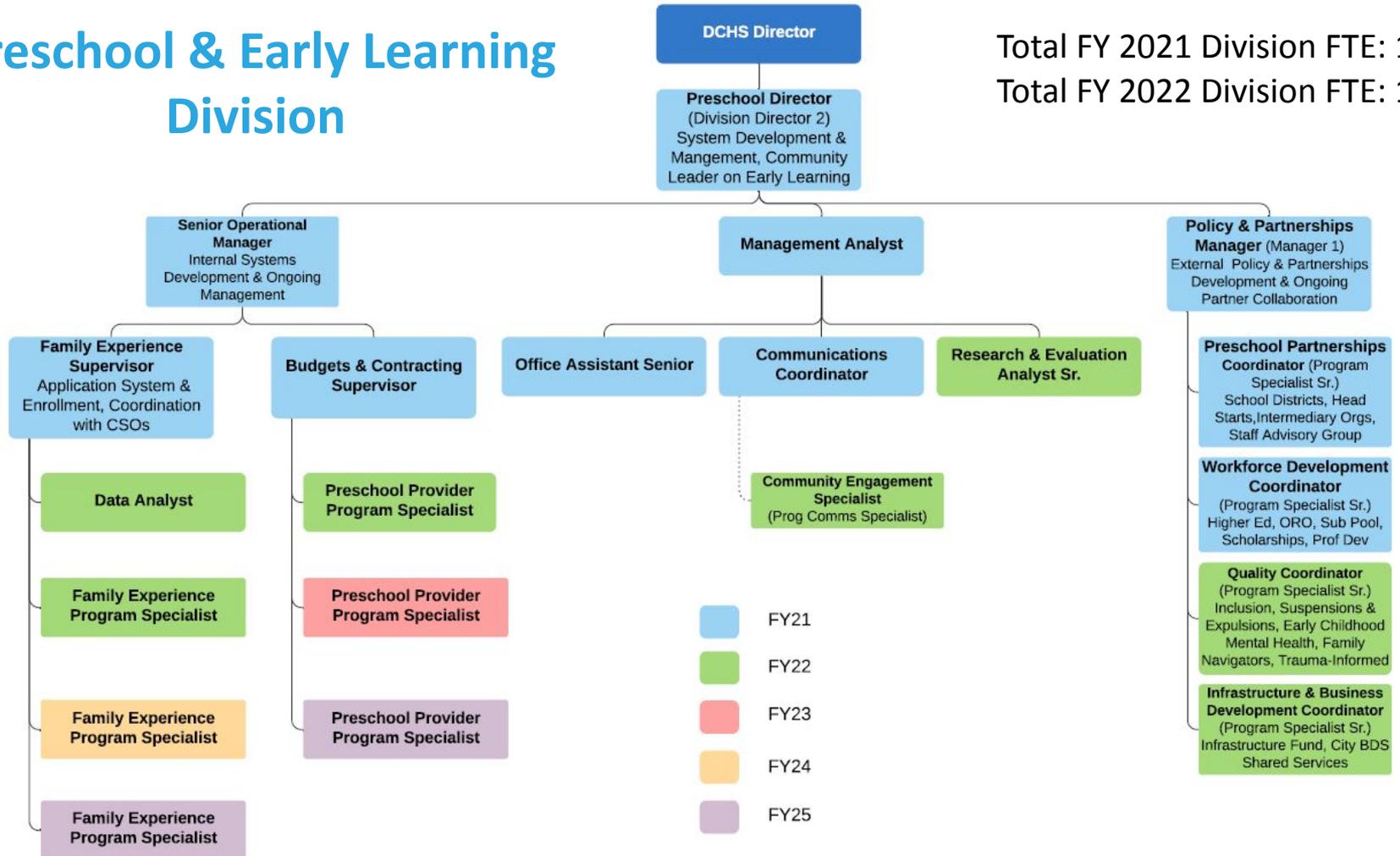

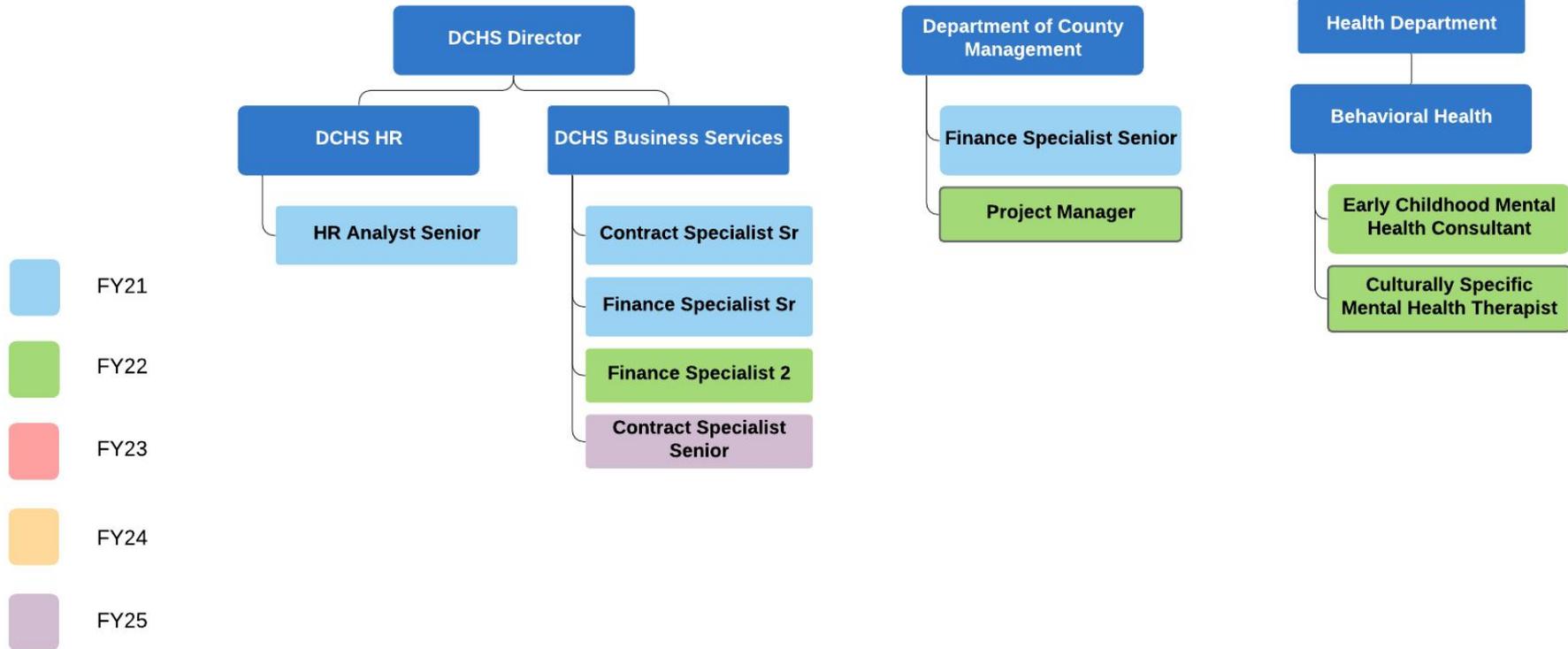
