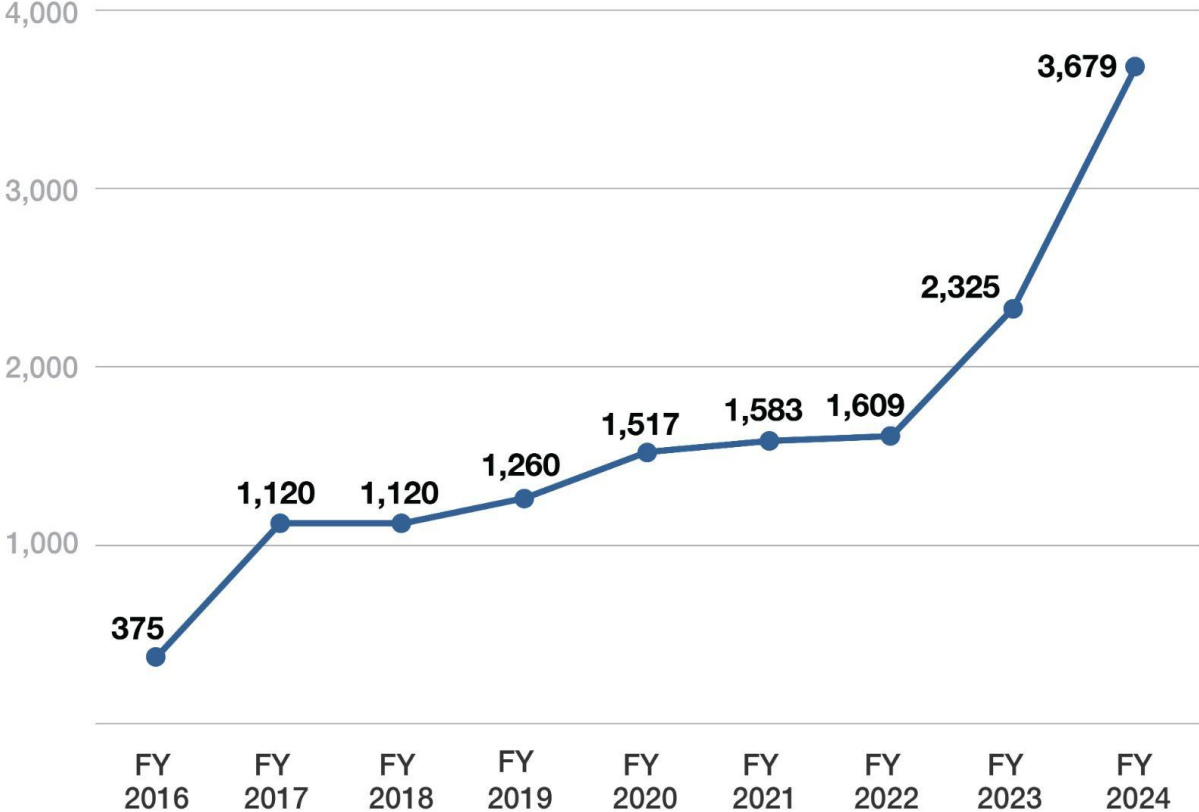

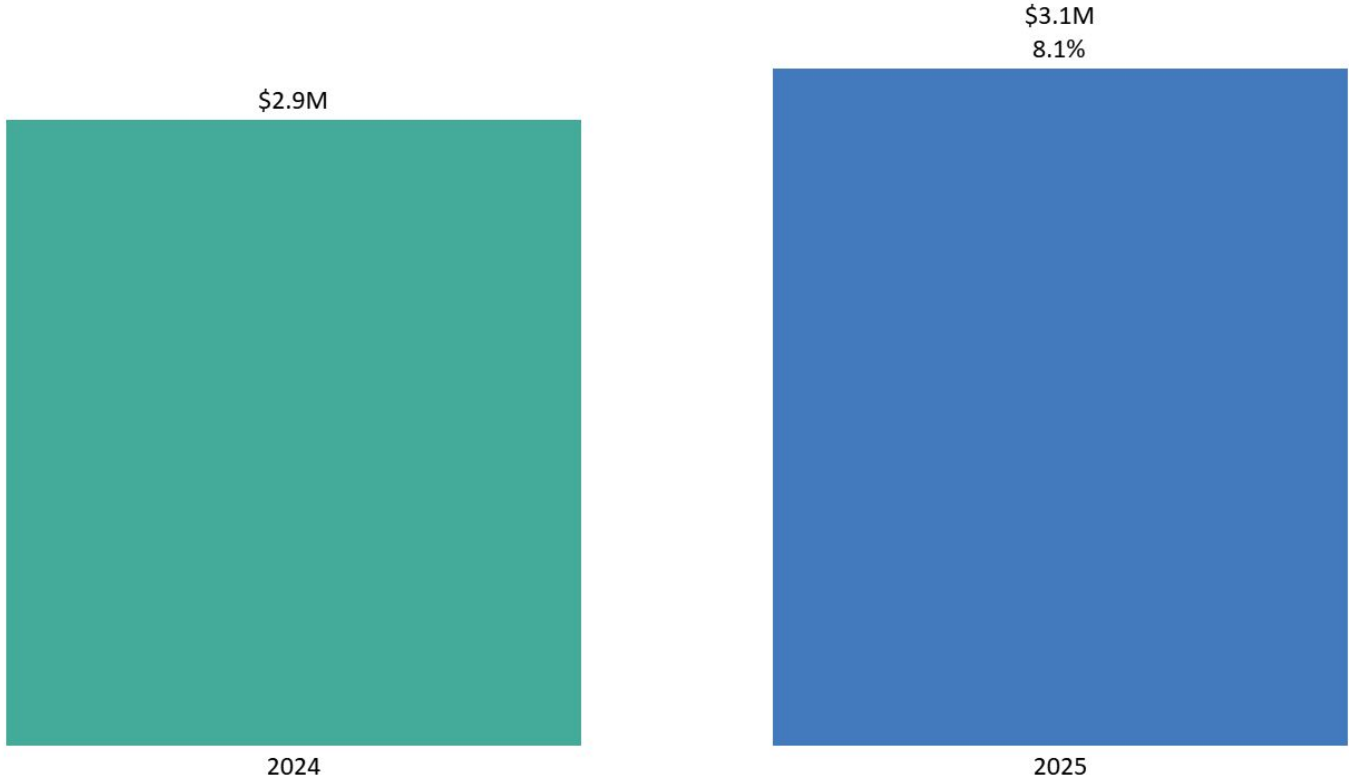




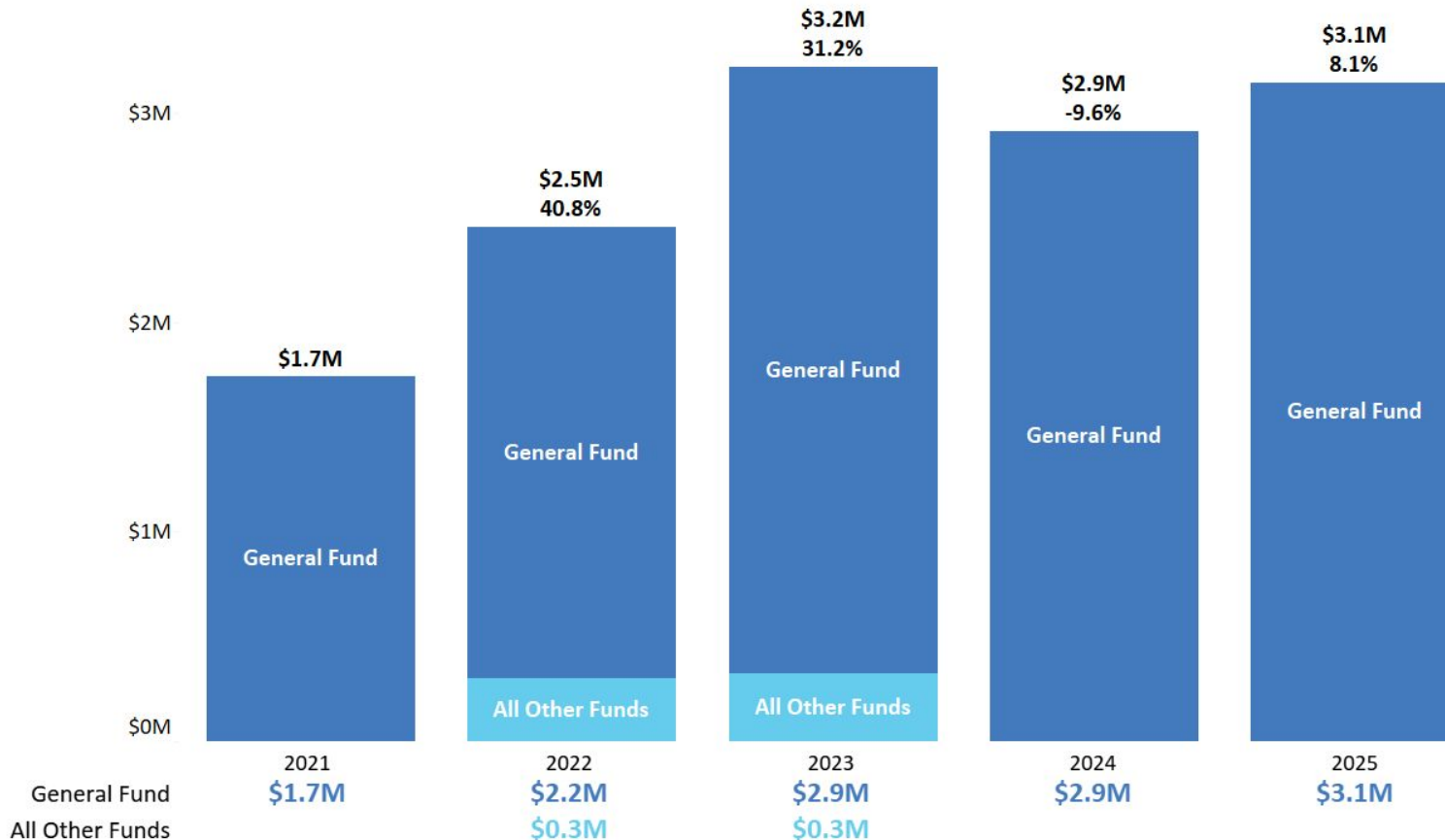


Operating Budget by Fund - \$3,144,772

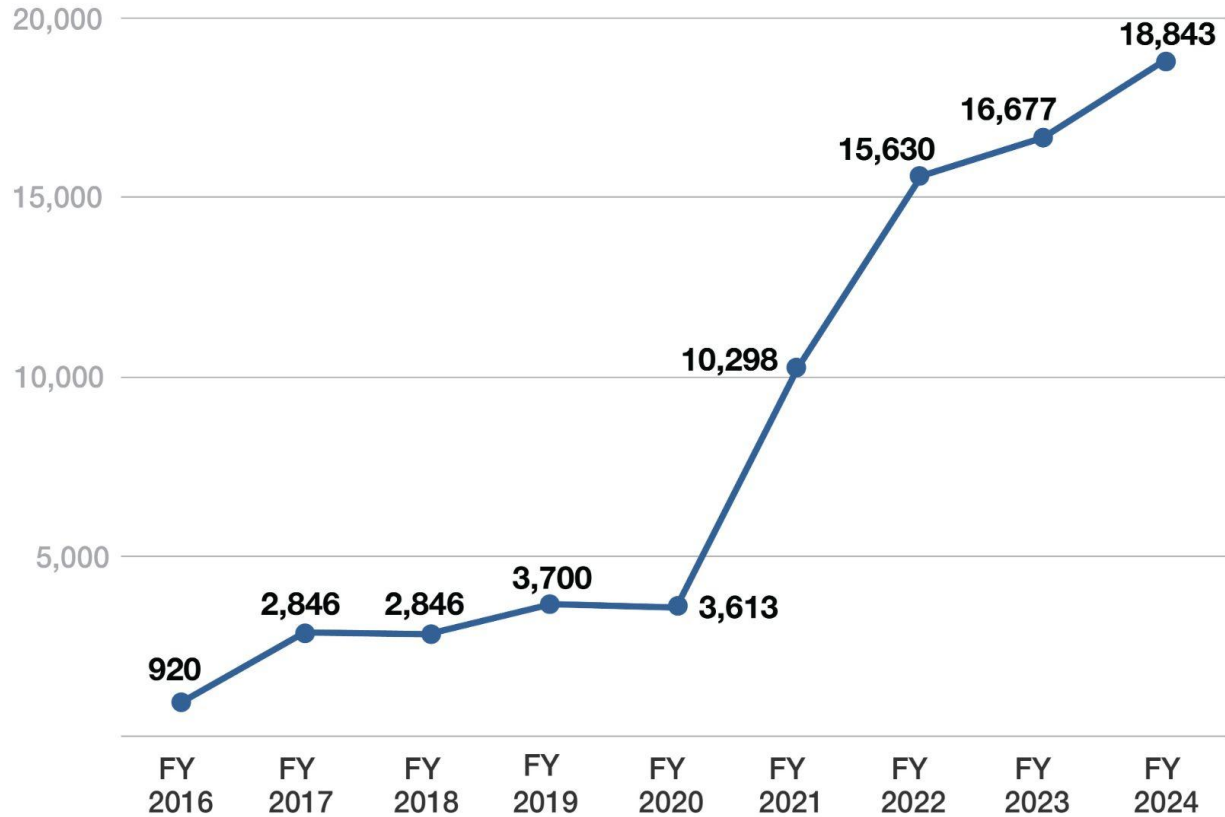

Background

On January 30, 2024, the [State of Oregon](#), [Multnomah County](#) and [City of Portland](#) each declared a 90-day state of emergency and launched a unified approach to address the fentanyl crisis in Portland's City Center. The tri-government approach is a first-of-its-kind strategy to better coordinate City, State and County efforts for short term and long term success. As of Feb 26, there are at least 46 staff assigned either full or part time in the incident management team.

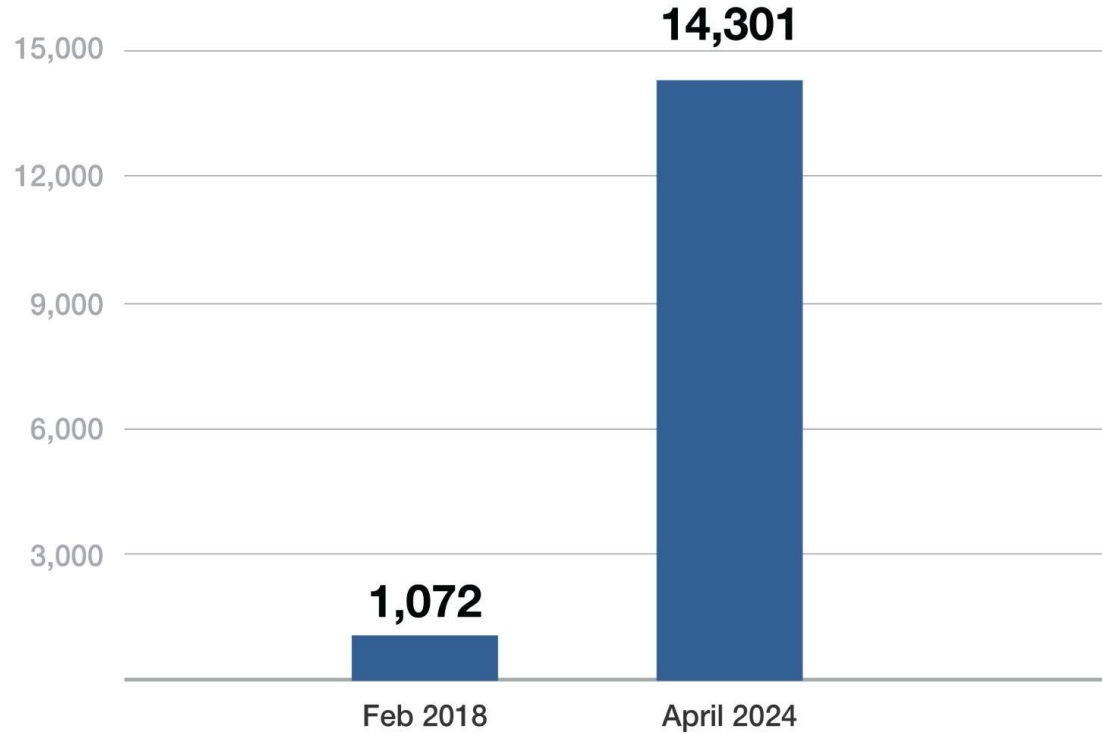


