

















































































Commissioners unanimously approve County's first-ever lobbying and transparency ordinance

How does bargaining work?


For each contract, the Union and Management will come to the table (literally - it's a table) to talk through what each side would like to change from the previous contract. This can include housekeeping things like switching to gender-







Daisy the dog




Operating Budget by Fund: \$3,385,907






FTE Trend FY 2019-2026






Operating Budget by Category - \$3,385,907
