Can you please provide some health data outcomes that you track?

Response:

The Health Center tracks health outcomes in a few different ways. One way is through our Federal Uniform Data Submission, where our performance is compared across all health centers and the data is publicly shared, including the quartile analysis for clinical quality of care measures. In addition, the Health Center participates in Coordinated Care Organization metrics at the state level and the Alternate Payment Methodology and Advanced Care Model Program ([APCM](#)) through our partners at the Oregon Primary Care Association, where quality metrics are tracked and tied to financial outcomes.

We have started the process of creating a comprehensive and robust info sheet that provides details of the health outcomes question asked by Commissioner Brim-Edwards. We anticipate having this completed by the last week of June.
