MAAP DDAs help to address local safety issues driven by local priorities, incorporating non-carceral solutions such as diversion programs, treatment, and restorative justice where possible, while pursuing accountability for high volume systems users. MAAP DDAs are not housed in police precincts because the presence of law enforcement may discourage some members of the community from accessing resources. To prevent this, MAAP utilizes shared spaces in the community, funded by nonprofit agencies, allowing partnerships to exist and engagement to occur without this unintended impact. The loss of this MAAP DDA will negatively impact the North Portland community specifically.
