Library: Please provide any policy information related to commercial events that could be held at the East County Library that would include the commercial entity selling tickets to an event held at the library for profit. Is there a limit on entrance fees?

#### Response:

Per the library's Auditorium and rooftop terrace policy draft, "Admission fees to events are not allowed, except by nonprofits and the library." No commercial entity would be able to sell tickets to an event held at the library. There is not a cap on entrance fees by non-profits.
