Gender Pathways program and services

The Gender Pathways Clinic provides culturally competent care to transgender and gender-diverse patients. It's a unique place for members to receive integrated care in a comfortable, supporting setting.

At Kaiser Permanente, we understand that everyone's path to wellness is unique.

That's why the Gender Pathways Clinic offers a variety of skilled treatment options that start with equally skilled listening.

Consultations are given in a safe, compassionate environment, with the knowledge and belief that as your path begins, your goals may change, and that the closer you move toward your authentic life, true health will follow.

GENDER PATHWAYS CLINIC SERVICES:

- Information and referrals
- Education and preparation for transition-related care

MEDICAL SERVICES:

- Hormones
- Pubertal suppressants

OTHER GENDER-AFFIRMING SERVICES:

- Facial, body, and genital hair removal (via electrolysis, offered as a referral to community partners, not offered in-house)
- Voice training
- Community navigator
- Social work services

SURGICAL SERVICES:

- Top surgery (chest contouring and breast augmentation)
- Orchiectomy
- Hysterectomy
- Oophorectomy
- Chondrolaryngoplasty (tracheal shave)
- Metoidioplasty (in partnership with OHSU)
- Phalloplasty (in partnership with OHSU)
- Facial gender confirmation surgery (in partnership with OHSU)
- Vaginoplasty (in partnership with OHSU)
- Vulvoplasty (in partnership with OHSU)

Your care team would consist of clinical specialists from internal medicine, family medicine, pediatric, endocrinology, gynecology, psychiatry, surgery, social work, nursing, and community health navigation.
