














WHAT IS GVRC IN MULTNOMAH COUNTY?


- Fatality review commission to identify and implement systems-level solutions (other commissions review child fatalities, overdoses, domestic violence)
- Commissions are one of five programs elevated by Johns Hopkins University Center for Gun Violence Solutions to reduce community gun violence (Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health. Violence Reduction Councils: A Community Approach to Saving Lives, July 2024)
- By 7 years after implementation, Milwaukee Homicide Review Commission associated with **52% decrease** in monthly count of homicides in districts where Commission interventions were implemented (see Azrael et al., 2013)




