




HB 3194 // 120 Day Supervision

- ✓ Group agrees on conditions resulting in 120 days of high level supervision
- ✓ Court is notified of specific violations
- ✓ Specific Judges and Parole and Probation Officers are assigned to MCJRP
- ✓ Program provides upfront intensive resources


