What Does the Health Center Communications and Marketing Team Do?

Multnomah County Community Health Center is a division within the Health Department that operates a network of 18 safety net health clinics, primarily serving OHP, Medicaid, and under- or uninsured community members. Each year 50,000 patients get the health care they need at our clinics across Multnomah County. We offer team-based care to support all parts of our patients' health.

As the largest Federally Qualified Health Center in Oregon, we're proud to provide quality care to everyone in our community.





Our network includes:

- 7 clinics with medical, dental, and pharmacy services
- 9 school-based clinics for children ages 5-18
- 1 dental-only clinic in downtown Portland
- 1 clinic that specializes in care for people living with HIV

The Communication and Marketing team supports our clinic staff and patients by providing important and relevant information about our clinics, programs, and health resources.

Internship Description & Responsibilities:

- Visit Health Center clinics, meet and interview staff (providers, front desk, eligibility, student health, dental, pharmacy, community health workers, etc). Write articles and success stories about the work they do. Stories will be shared with staff in our Health Centers and County-wide.
- Assist with planning for events like Pride, Community Health Center Week, and other community events. Assist with tabling at these events and speaking to community members about our work.
- Develop content and graphics for flyers, our website and social media
- Assist with ordering and distributing swag to clinics and teams to use at community events
- Attend meetings with Communications and Marketing team, assist with understanding deliverables and implementing them
- Coordinate with SHC intern
