STEPS TO VOTING BY MAIL

(1) REGISTER TO VOTE

IN PERSON: Visit us at 1040 SE Morrison St, Portland, OR 97233 or 600 NE 8th St. Gresham (Open 21 days before each election).



PRINT & MAIL: Visit MultnomahVotes.gov and print a voter registration card.

Remember: Register by deadline, 21 days before the election.

Going overseas? You can register to have your ballot mailed 45 days before the election. Contact us to learn more.

(2) GET YOUR BALLOT IN THE MAIL



Ballots are mailed about 21 days before the election.



Ballots cannot be forwarded to new address, remember to update your address.



Will-call and Replacement Ballot service is available at both locations.

Remember: If you are going to be away from your mail, you can sign up for an absentee ballot. Contact us to find out how.

VOTE YOUR BALLOT



Use a blue or black ink pen to fill in the ovals (Do not use a felt pen).



If you make a mistake: make correction on the ballot OR request a replacement ballot.



Check your ballot: Make sure you have not made more choices than we can count.



Only fill out one oval per choice for single choice voting ballots.



Fill in up to six ovals based on your preference for ranked choice voting ballots.



Place the ballot in the return envelope and seal, sign your ballot return envelope.

(4) RETURN YOUR BALLOT

Library BY LIBRARY: Multnomah County Libraries are also Official drop sites.



BY MAIL: No stamp needed. Ballots must be postmarked by Election Day to be counted.

Remember: Ballots must be dropped off by 8:00 pm on Election Day.

TRACK YOUR BALLOT



Sign up for Track Your Ballot at Multnomah.BallotTrax.net and receive alerts via text, phone or email and get your virtual "I Voted" sticker, available in multiple languages.

CHECK ELECTION RESULTS



Results will begin posting at 8pm on Election night at MultnomahVotes.gov. Results are updated as all ballots are counted, and results remain unofficial until certification.
