Registration Card

- Oregon Voter Registration Cards are available in six languages.
- Please fill out the form using a **black** or **blue ink** pen and print clearly.
- Fill out all sections. If the form is incomplete, it may be rejected and returned to the voter for completion.

** You will need an Oregon Driver's License or DMV ID number to register online.



Use this form to register to vote in Oregon

- You may also use the form to:
 - Change your name
 - Change your signature
 - Update your mailing address
 - Update your residence address
 - Select a Political party affiliation on your voter registration
 - Become eligible to sign petitions, including initiative, referendum and recall petitions
- Note: The deadline to register to vote is the 21st day before every election.

- **Are you a resident of Oregon?**

A person who lives in Oregon with the intention of making Oregon their home. A person who has come to Oregon for temporary purposes and intends to return to another state is not considered a resident for voting purposes. If you are uncertain about residency, contact the elections office.

- **Are you a citizen of the United States of America?**

You must be a citizen of the United States of America to be eligible to vote.

- **Are you at least 16 years of age?**

You will receive a ballot for the next election that occurs on or after your 18th birthday.

However, if you provide your phone number and/or email this will not be public record and can be very useful for Elections staff in contacting you to troubleshoot registration or voting problems.

- Choose ONE of the political parties from the list. You may only choose one party. If a mistake is made, make sure your intent is clear or fill out a new card. If more than one party is indicated you will be registered as “Not a member of a party”.
- Check or fill in the circle to the left of the party name.
- If your party is not listed, select “*Other*” and fill in the name of your party.
- If you do not want to be affiliated with a political party, you may check the box that states “*Not a member of a party*”.
- You may not designate or change party affiliation after the 21st day before the primary election.
- ***Some political parties require you to be registered in their party to vote for their candidates in a closed Primary Election.***



Oregon DMV Driver's License/ID Number

Provide a valid Oregon Driver's License, Permit or ID:

- Fill in your valid Oregon DMV Driver's License/ID Number in the boxes provided.
- If you do not have a valid Oregon DMV Driver's License/ID mark the circle below the boxes and use the last 4 digits of your Social Security Number.

ID Requirements

- The law requires that you must provide identification information to register to vote.
- If you have a current, valid Oregon DMV Driver's License/ID you must provide that number on the registration card.
- A suspended Driver's License is valid, a revoked Driver's License is not valid.



ID Requirements

- If you do not have a current, valid Oregon Driver's License/ID or a Social Security number, you must affirm this by marking the appropriate boxes on the registration card, and if registering by mail, you must provide a copy of one of the following:
 - Valid photo identification
 - Government document
 - A paycheck stub (showing name and address)
 - Utility bill (showing name and address)
 - Bank statement (showing name and address)
 - Proof of eligibility under the Uniformed and Overseas Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA) or the Voting Accessibility for the Elderly & Handicapped Act (VAEH)



Very Important!



- Failure to provide the required ID will prevent county election officials from counting votes for Federal Contests at a Primary or General Election, including contest for President of the United States.

Signature

- By signing you swear or affirm that you are qualified to be an elector and that you have told the truth on your registration card.
- ***Registration cards must be signed!***
- A voter who is unable, because of a disability, to sign their name should also complete the [Signature Stamp Attestation form](#).

- You can also see your registration online at www.oregonvotes.gov/myvote.



Registration Drives

- If you are conducting a voter registration drive:
 - Once a completed card is submitted to your group you may not alter any information on the card.
(ORS 247.125)
 - You have 5 days to deliver the card to an Elections Office. Do not hold on to completed registration cards. (ORS 247.012(2)(a))
- You may NOT keep a photocopy of the registration card unless you block out the voter's signature, DMV Driver's License/ID number, and Social Security number.
