

# 6 Steps to a Complete Immunization Report

| <b>Step 1</b> | <b>Fall</b>                | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Collect immunization records for each child enrolled at your facility.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Sign up for the ALERT immunization registry (<a href="http://www.alertiis.org">www.alertiis.org</a>) to access immunization records for children at your facility.</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Step 2</b> | <b>Fall</b>                | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Using <b>ALERT, Transparent Overlays, or the Immunization Primary Review Table</b>, assess each child's record. Determine which children are not up to date.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Set a deadline for parents to get the updated records returned to you.</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Step 3</b> | <b>December/January</b>    | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Once records are assessed and updated, fill out Section A (Page 1) of the <b>Immunization Primary Review Summary</b>. Make a copy, and keep it for your records.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> <b><i>If all children are up-to-date</i></b>, complete Step 6 and email, fax, or mail Page 1 <b>and</b> Pages 3 and 4 to the Multnomah County Health Department (MCHD) by January 17, 2024. You are finished!<br/><b>OR...</b></li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> <b><i>If you have children with incomplete or missing records</i></b>, fill out Section B (Page 2) of the <b>Immunization Primary Review Summary</b> with the names, grades, birthdates, and addresses of children who have incomplete/missing records. Make a copy, and keep it for your records. Move on to Step 4.</li> </ul> |
| <b>Step 4</b> | <b>By January 17, 2024</b> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Email, fax, or mail the following to the Multnomah County Health Department (MCHD):             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Section A (Page 1)</li> <li>▪ Section B (Page 2)</li> <li>▪ Photocopies of the <b>CIS forms</b> or ALERT records for the children listed in Section B.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>   |

MCHD will re-assess the records of the children that are not up to date and will issue **Exclusion Orders** to parents on February 7, 2024. Copies of Sections B, C, and D (Page 2) and copies of the Exclusion Orders will be sent to your school or facility. These documents confirm the immunizations each child needs to receive in order to prevent exclusion.

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| <b>Step 5</b> | <b>Between February 7 and February 21, 2024 (Exclusion Day)</b> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Fill out Section D (Page 2) of the <b>Immunization Primary Review Summary</b> with the dates records are returned to you (cancelling exclusion orders).</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> If a child's record is not up to date by the beginning of the school day on February 21, 2024, they will not be able to attend school UNTIL you have an updated record. If updated records are returned AFTER the beginning of the school day on February 21, 2024, the child is considered "Excluded." Mark a "Y" in the appropriate column in Section D (Page 2) of the <b>Immunization Primary Review Summary</b>. Make a copy, and keep it for your records.</li> </ul> |

**Between February 22  
and March 4, 2024**

- ☐ Using the **Tally Worksheets**, complete the **Immunization Primary Review Summary** – Section E (Page 3), and Sections F, G, H (Page 4) as appropriate for your facility.
  - Section E for preschool, daycare, or Head Start
  - Section F for Kindergarten
  - Section G for 7<sup>th</sup> graders
  - Section H for Kindergarten-12<sup>th</sup> gradersMake a copy, and keep it for your records.

**By March 4, 2024**

  - Page 3 of the Immunization Primary Review Summary.
