

Attention!</p> <p>Remember to inspect your ballot for mistakes! If you make a mistake or damage your ballot, call your County Elections Office to ask for assistance.</p> <hr/> <p>! Check for Errors</p> <p>If you vote for more options than allowed, your vote will not count for that candidate or measure.</p>
