Business: We need to thoughtfully develop the buildable land we have left in Fairview to provide the largest number of family-wage jobs possible. With the severe shortage of buildable land in the Portland metro area, we don't need to give huge tax breaks or other costly incentives to attract developers, while unfairly shifting the tax burden onto the rest of the businesses and citizens of Fairview.

Public Safety: I want to ensure the safety and well-being of all the citizens of Fairview, along with the safety of our dedicated and hardworking Fairview police officers. The consolidation of Fairview's police department into the Multnomah County Sheriff's Office should only be considered if it is conclusively demonstrated that it will reduce crime rates and improve response times, for the same price or less than Fairview taxpayers are now paying.

Integrity: Fairview's city council needs members with integrity, experience, and vision. But even beyond these requirements, our councilors need to have a spirit of respect, appreciation, and cooperation between themselves, the city's staff, and the community. There has been way too much posturing and polarizing within the Fairview City Council recently that needs to end.
