The Chair, ED and county attorney have been working on a second version that will include detail around voting procedures and the newly formed executive committee. The group reviewed the revisions. Feedback included:
	<b>Content</b> Move responsibilities to the top near the purpose.
	Review the statute and ensure membership described in statute matches bylaws.
	Subcommittees need to be tightened.
	Recommendation - Executive Committee membership should be approved by voting members and be up for change annually. Members may nominate themselves.
	Timeline and approval process

	Staff will review these comments with the county attorney and share changes with the group. If possible, the Council will approve them in January. We will send them out to voting members prior to the meeting. Highlight what is in the statute so people know what is negotiable and what isn't.
