❑ Register to VOTE.

October 13 Voter Registration Deadline

Update your voter registration

- anytime that you move,
- change your name,
- or want to change your party affiliation.

Sign up for **Track Your Ballot** to be notified when we mail your ballot to you and when your vote is counted. Sign up at multnomah.ballottrax.net.

❑ Get Your Ballot.

You will receive your ballot in the mail beginning October 14. If you have not received your ballot by October 22 call the elections office at (503)988-VOTE (8683) for a replacement ballot.

Use our online Order Ahead Replacement Ballot Service starting October 22 if needed at multco.us/orderahead.

If you are going to be away from home for this election sign up to get an absentee ballot, available starting September 21.

❑ VOTE Your Ballot.

Remember to **sign your ballot return envelope**. Your signature is your identification. Every signature on every ballot is examined to make sure it matches the signature in the voter's registration. If you forget to sign or your signature does not match we will send you a letter and contact you via Track Your Ballot so that you can take action and we can count your vote.

Do you have questions or need help voting? We have voter assistance available to help if you have a disability or need help in a language other than English. Call us.



❑ Return your Ballot

You can return your ballot by mail. No stamp needed! Get your ballot in the mail to us by Tuesday, October 27 to ensure it is received by our office on time. Postmarks do not count in Oregon.

You can return your ballot to an Official Ballot Drop Site. Return your ballot to any 24-hour Official Ballot Drop Box in the State or to any 24-hour Multnomah County Library Drop Site.
