**03-169 MEASURE APPROVING
ANNEXATION OF CITY OF OREGON
CITY PROPERTY TO DISTRICT**

Question: Shall Clackamas County Fire District #1 annex all of the territory of the City of Oregon City?

Summary: If annexation is approved by both District and city of Oregon City electors, territory within the City would become part of the fire district. Clackamas County Fire District #1 has provided fire and emergency medical services to the City under a contract between the City and the District. All former City fire personnel are now District employees. The City Commission of Oregon City has proposed that the District annex all of the property within the City for the purpose of providing fire and emergency services to the City. Territory within the City would be subject to District property taxes at District tax rates to pay for fire and emergency medical services. City property would be subject to tax to pay any District bonds and other liabilities on the same basis as other property in the District. City electors would be eligible to vote in District elections. The City would no longer provide fire and emergency medical services. The District Board has approved the annexation, subject to approval of the electors of the City of Oregon City and the approval of the electors of Clackamas County Fire District #1.

26-74 FIVE-YEAR LOCAL OPTION LEVY FOR GENERAL OPERATING PURPOSES

Question: Shall Sauvie Island Volunteer R.F.P.D. #30JT impose \$.46 per \$1000. of assessed value for five years for operating purposes beginning 2005-06? This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.

Summary: This measure may be passed only at an election with at least a fifty percent voter turnout. The taxes will be used for general operating purposes for Sauvie Island Volunteer R.F.P.D. #30JT. Anticipated uses include mandatory medical testing for all firefighters, required OSHA testing on equipment, and annual servicing and safety inspections of vehicles, including funds for equipment replacement. The rate is estimated to raise the following amounts: \$55,201. in 2005-06; \$56,867. in 2006-07; \$58,563. in 2007-08; \$60,320. in 2008-09; and \$62,130. in 2009-10 for a total of \$293,072.

**03-166 ANNEXATION TO CFD1 AND
REDUCTION OF CITY TAX
CERTIFICATION.**

Question: Shall Milwaukie annex to CFD1 for fire and emergency medical services and reduce City tax certification to prevent tax increase?

Summary: If approved this measure will annex the territory within the City to Clackamas Fire District No. 1 (CFD1). City residents will continue to receive fire and emergency medical services from CFD1. CFD1 is a service district governed by an elected Board of CFD1 residents; it provides fire and emergency medical services. The City will continue to provide all other services it currently provides. The measure also requires that the City reduce its property tax rate certification so that the total rate levied by the City and CFD1 is no more than the total rate they currently levy. Voter approval at a future election would be required to increase the City's tax rate.

If the annexation is approved, CFD1's permanent tax rate (2.4012) per \$1,000 of assessed valuation) is assessed on real property within the City effective July 1, 2005, and the City will reduce its tax rate certification by the same amount. Taxes cannot be increased without voter approval.
