Mount Hood Community College is a unique and important community asset. Our system of community colleges provides an important transition from secondary instruction to an affordable pathway leading to a four-year academic degree, or a more immediate vocational certificate.

For the past seventeen years I have served as an MHCC foundation volunteer - observing both the institution's successes and failures. That association and understanding have been enhanced by the opportunity to work with the institution's presidents, administrators, instructors, support personnel, and, most importantly, the students.

Funding for community colleges is significantly less than that of the State's institutions of higher education, and, as a consequence, demands stricter cost/benefit accounting. As a board member it will be my focus to intently evaluate all of the resources that fund the college's academic and infrastructure programs, including expanded budget and audit reviews. Student aid and government grants programs will also receive scrutiny to maximize their value and reduce any opportunities for misuse.

My long-term interest in the affairs of the college include a continual review of the MHCC's Board of Education minutes and budget documents. Additionally, I also endeavor to review both state and federal legislation that may have a relationship to the maintenance of the area's community colleges.

The basic premise of my campaign is that of serving the community, and to promote the continuation of affordable, high quality education for our future generations.
