Racial Equity Questions

Goal: Have a short set of questions we ask ourselves as a subcommittee about each recommendation we put to the full committee.

- People: Who is impacted by this recommendation and how?
- Place: How does the recommendation change the way specific communities experience the places they live? What about the places they receive County services?
- Place: How does the recommendation change how resources flow to historically underinvested places in the county, and does it meet the needs of our most vulnerable communities and populations?
- Process: How does the recommendation meaningfully empower communities of color and other underserved populations to engage and have voice in decision making processes?
- Power: How will the community at-large, specific populations and the county workforce be overburdened or underburdened by the recommendation?
- Power: How clearly does the recommendation outline accountability and for whom?
