Multnomah County Justice Reinvestment Program (MCJRP) Changes effective November 1, 2025

1. Eligibility and New Case Track System will be identified on the charging document.

- Track 1 Cases: Likely Probation Offer
 - No ASAM or JSC required;
 - Pre-trial offer sent to defense within 21 days;
 - Plea or set dates at the Further Proceeding Call date around 49 days from indictment.
 - MCDA has indicated that in most cases the early PTO will expire at the FP date set around 49 days.
- Track 2 cases: Additional mitigation required
 - Defense provides ASAM and additional mitigation as needed;
 - o JSC prior to pre-trial offer and resolution.

2. Pre-adjudication Report (PAR)

- The Department of Community Justice (DCJ) will prepare the PAR for all MCJRP eligible cases. DCJ will not interview defendants.
- The PAR will be sent to the Court Coordinator.
- The PAR contains case information, defendants' demographic information, a risk assessment, preliminary treatment court eligibility, responsivity needs and a supervision summary.

3. Time to disposition Standards

 The Court intends to adhere to the Supreme Court's Time to Disposition Standards for MCJRP eligible cases.
