BALLOT TITLE:

CAPTION: Scappoose School District bond to replace and upgrade facilities.

QUESTION: Shall the District issue general obligation bonds totaling \$15 million to finance new construction and capital improvements? If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

SUMMARY: This measure may be passed only at an election with at least a 50 percent voter turnout.

The Scappoose School District is experiencing aging buildings and increased facility needs. The District continues to spend substantial amounts of tax money to heat the high school where there is no insulation in the roof.

The bond will:

- construct, equip and furnish a new middle school on property that the District currently owns.
- update fire suppression system, insulate and install new roof at Scappoose High School.

The bonds will mature over a period not exceeding 26 years from date of issuance and may be issued in one or more series.
