## Lynn Peterson Voter Guide 2022

Occupation: Metro Regional Council

Metro plays a critical role protecting our quality of life, managing parks and open space, and supporting transit and mobility solutions. Frustrated by inaction and leadership failure, Lynn Peterson stepped up, engaging Metro to help tackle the homelessness and housing crises. Instead of ignoring the problem or blaming others, Peterson got to work:

**IMMEDIATE Housing:** Because of Lynn's insistence on accountability and maximizing resources, the voter-approved Metro Housing Bond has already funded over 3000 units, and is on pace to deliver over 6000 new, affordable homes – 30% more than initially planned.

**OVERDUE Homeless Services:** Until Lynn demanded action, winning voter support for homeless services, there was no government coordination to help people off our streets. Lynn led a program that opened more than 450 shelter beds and 1,000 supportive housing units in its first six months. That same program helped prevent 1,400 Oregonians from losing their homes.

**EXPANDING Garbage Cleanup:** In the past year, Lynn has expanded Metro's monthly garbage cleanup rate by 10-fold, now picking up 2 tons of waste from our streets every day. She has demanded similar urgency from the State of Oregon and City of Portland.
