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Current County Efforts – Linking Offenders to Treatment

- Forensic Mental Health Diversion
- Mental Health Court
- Community Court



Recent Grant opportunities to expand and connect services

- Forensic Assertive Community Treatment - \$500,000 grant awarded for one year (Health Share of Oregon in partnership with Cascadia, & DCHS)
- Jail Diversion Mental Health Services - \$500,000 grant awarded for 4/1/14 – 6/30/15 (MCHD, DCHS, & Cascadia)
- Second Chance Act Reentry Program – up to \$600,000 for 10/1/14 – 9/30/16 (DCJ, MCSO, MCHD & Cascadia) *pending funding September 2014*



Pilot Projects for FY 2015

- Program #40059: Corrections Health - Mental Health suicide watch support and assessment - \$385,820; 4.20 FTE
- Program #25051: Assessment & Treatment Center (CATC) – Behavioral Health Triage for Adults - \$658,721
- Program #50041: Supportive Housing with focus on Mental Health needs - \$365,000
