- Inform the public about issues people face when they try to access housing and homeless services.
   Currently auditing Joint Office of Homeless Services' information systems and data reporting.

During my second term, I will cement this progress and build on it. Government auditing is absolutely necessary to ensure accountable, transparent, equitable government operations. I will continue to work for you and be accountable to you.
