I've spent 32 years serving Multnomah County residents on the frontlines.

HOW TO FIX IT:

I will introduce the **Multnomah County Homelessness Reduction Act** to disrupt the path to homelessness.

Prevention first: A program I built from the ground up kept 2,800 households housed, with 90% still housed a year later. Track and publicly report housing retention at three, six, nine and twelve months for every County-funded program.

Rebuild addiction treatment around long-term recovery: My program combines housing, treatment and employment for 12 to 24 months. Measure treatment completion, housing stability and whether people move toward self-sufficiency.

Invest in District 2: Bring resources and opportunity home.

I will also introduce the **Multnomah County Accountability and Results Act**, a public **County Report Card** showing what we spend, what's working, what's not and where we need to improve.

Government should be measured by whether people's lives are getting better and taxpayers' money is producing results.

I'm not running on theory. I've spent three decades building programs, managing public resources and delivering measurable results. **Look at the record.**
