- 78 Traffic Fatalities in 2020  
(55 in 2016)
- 799 Overdose Deaths in Oregon  
(506 in 2016)
- 62 Homicides in 2020  
(22 in 2016)

# Gun Violence Prevention Framework

## **Gun Violence is a Public Health and Public Safety Problem**

Gun violence includes group violence, domestic violence, self-harm, extreme risk and criminal acts committed using a firearm

Our response will be centered on strategies from public health

Strategies to reduce gun violence should have the support of communities impacted by the violence and be grounded in a restorative justice model
