Below are some concerns I have regarding the proposed cell tower at the site. Has the cell tower issue been addressed?

Cell phone towers can affect the environment through the emission of radiofrequency (RF) radiation, habitat destruction during construction, and the potential for microplastic pollution. While the effects of RF radiation on human health are still being researched, some studies suggest potential harm to wildlife, including birds, bees, and other insects. Additionally, the construction and maintenance of cell towers can disrupt natural habitats and contribute to pollution.

Studies suggest that EMR can disrupt bird and bee navigation, potentially leading to disorientation and difficulty finding their way back to their nests or hives. Additionally, some research indicates that EMR exposure can impact bird behavior, reproductive success, and even lead to DNA damage in honey bee larvae.
