Bonds would mature over not more than 15 years and may be issued in series. Due to declining debt service on existing bonds, the measure will not increase TVF&R's bond tax rate above the current rate of \$0.1415 per \$1,000 AV unless assessed property values decline. For property assessed at \$300,000, about the average in TVF&R's service area, the bond cost is estimated to be \$42.45 per year or \$3.54 per month.
