Overview

- Legislative approval of additional OPDC Trial Division attorneys and staff
- *State v. Roberts* – Oregon Supreme Court Decision – Cases pending without counsel appointed for 90 days (felonies) or 60 days (misdemeanors) must be dismissed without prejudice. MCDA may reinstate the case. 852 cases have been dismissed to date. 26 of those have been re-indicted.
- Identification of qualified cases by DA's office at issuance
- April 14, 2026 – first resolution docket
- Estimates 100+ cases per month may be eligible
- Early Pretrial Offer and Discovery provided by DA's office
- OPDC attorney retains case if initial offer not accepted.



Pretrial Offers

- Pretrial Offers
 - Case reduced to misdemeanor
 - Shorter period of formal probation
 - MCJRP Track 1 Cases – early probation offer
- Eligible Cases
 - Many presumptive probation Class C felonies
 - MCJRP Track 1 cases (defendants with less extensive criminal histories)
- Ineligible Cases
 - No person crimes
 - No DCS cases
 - No DUII Cases
 - Several other disqualifying factors
