During 30 years of elected service on the PCC Board, at Multnomah County and at the City of Portland, I have worked on these issues and have demonstrated the ability to establish sound policy, good labor relations, and listen to concerns of our students and residents – all while working within a balanced budget.

My priorities include:

- Ensuring educational programs remain relevant and in demand by employers.
- Helping Veterans transition their skills to the private or public sector.
- Expanding the number of students and scholarships for the Portland Rise to Teach Program, a joint program of PSU and PCC, to increase the number of minority teachers in our local schools.
- Ensuring every student has an equal shot at success, and that they complete their studies; that our
 workforce reflects our population; and that we provide procurement opportunities for minority and
 women-owned businesses.

I have also pushed for PCC to consider partnering with affordable housing developers to develop housing for students, and others; and to think creatively about developing vacant PCC land or surface parking lots into affordable housing. I'm pleased to report near completion of one such project at our NE 42nd Opportunity Center, and the groundbreaking in May for another at our Southeast Portland Campus.
