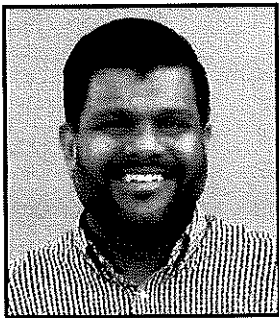



I've worked in the nonprofit sector for over a decade, including 4 years in the inner city of Chicago, which has shaped my policies and goals for Portland's future. My experience working on the ground in different communities puts me in a position to understand the concerns of Portland's diverse population. As the youngest candidate in the District 2 race, I want to represent my generation, particularly those who feel left out of this economy and are concerned about the climate crisis.

TOP PRIORITIES

1. **Pass a Renters' Bill of Rights:** Portlanders rent falls behind in renter protections. The bill would limit rent increases, cap fees, establish eviction representation, and penalize landlords who ignore code violations.
2. **Fully Fund the Portland Street Response:** Expanding PSR for 24/7 citywide coverage will send care, not cops, to a mental health crisis.
3. **Stop the Sweeps:** Street sweeps cost taxpayers millions yet still keep people unhoused. Instead, I want to open emergency temporary shelters across the city.
4. **Tax Billion Dollar Corporations:** Increasing the Portland Clean Energy Fund (PCEF) tax on billion-dollar corporations to 2% to pay for green infrastructure and renewable energy programs.
5. **Hold the Police Accountable:** I promise to pass the recommendations of the Police Accountability Commission, which allows for true civilian oversight of the PPB.






