Stopping Child Abuse - Will require annual screening of minors for child abuse, primarily for sexual abuse and extremer forms of physical abuse.

Budget Cuts - Have an estimated 1-1.5 billion dollars of budget cuts, mainly by cutting construction projects that have no significant value, and that have costs that are often 10-20 times the market rate due to corruption.

Lower Rent - Government ownership has shown to lower rent by around 30-40% due to the elimination of landlords, will test these models.

Homeless Relief - Need about 600 million to build new permanent shelters to house all homeless, have some temporary solutions as well.

Food Stamps - Will fund food stamps, need about 20-30 million annually.

Education Reforms - Main reforms will revolve around having 6-12th grade be more focused on students' desired occupation. Science of reading curriculum may be rolled out at the elementary school level.

Police Reforms - Will work to install video cameras at every intersection, use facial recognition technology to decrease profiling, invest in non-lethal equipment such as tranquilizers and multi-rounded bola wraps, increase training, increase police officers, increase drug K-9 units etc.

Save Lloyd - Will stop the demolition of Lloyd center, and roll out a more reasonable plan to revitalize the mall. Will save the city \$700 million.

Assisted living for the disabled - Will build assisted living centers for the disabled, with work opportunities on site.

Construction Projects - New Parks, new neighborhoods, increase lanes on freeways and streets to decrease congestion, new freeway entrances, eliminate potholes, and pave undeveloped streets.

No renovations on the Moda Center – None.

Sex Crime - Will work to stop atrocities such as abortions, trans-sexual surgery, sterilizing birth control, rape, child molestation, homo sexuality, and sex outside of marriage.
