I'm Teacher Tiffany, a Japanese American public school teacher, union organizer, and mom raising two kids in Southeast Portland. I'm proud to be the first Asian American woman elected to Portland's government, fighting for workers and families in the city we all love.

A pandemic, an affordability crisis, and decades of underinvestment hit Portland hard. I ran to represent District 3 in our new government because years in a classroom put me on the front lines of these challenges. As a democratic socialist and leader in the Working Families Party, I believe politics isn't about rich people working behind closed doors. I bring Portlanders into the rooms where decisions are made.

As your councilor, in under two years I've:

- Organized Portland's Trump response, passing legislation to **prevent collaboration with ICE** and **protect immigrant and LGBTQIA+ families**.
- Served as the first unanimously-elected Council VP, emphasizing **good governance**.
- Fought to **reduce traffic deaths**, funding road improvements and requiring new safety measures.
- Fought for a **fair deal for Portlanders in the Moda Center** negotiations.
- Demanded **transparency around data centers** and oil trains.
- Secured millions for **rental assistance and social housing** and banned AI-driven rent price fixing.
- Eased the **tax burden and reduced utility hikes** for working-class Portlanders.
- Won **\$1M for small businesses**.
