



Safety

Reduce tensions with police by having regular events for people to interact with the police at open house style events with classes, conversations, games, questions, and answers

Reduce crime by prosecuting repeat offenders.

Hire Police Officers who live in Portland.

Reduce trash by returning trash cans on busy street, bus stops, and in parks. Increase public restrooms.

Housing

Create a register to match up people with housing opportunities.

City should promote rooming and boarding houses with information and events to educate people on how to set-up rooming and boarding houses.

Use housing funds to upgrade properties by adding living space without changing neighborhood character.

Upgrading current houses keeps rent money local, and strengthens our economy.

No Tolls in Portland on I-5, I-205, or I-84

IT'S BIG DEAL I oppose road tolls because they will cost hundreds of \$\$ just to get to work or around town. They will flood YOUR neighborhood with toll avoiders. Portlanders shouldn't have to pay \$100's on Tolls to use our freeways.

Economy

Focus on employment that has upward mobility creating an economy that thrives.

Transportation

Build a third bridge between Portland and Vancouver to decrease congestion while strengthening the economy and protecting our environment. There are twelve bridges over the Willamette River and we need more than two over the Columbia.


