



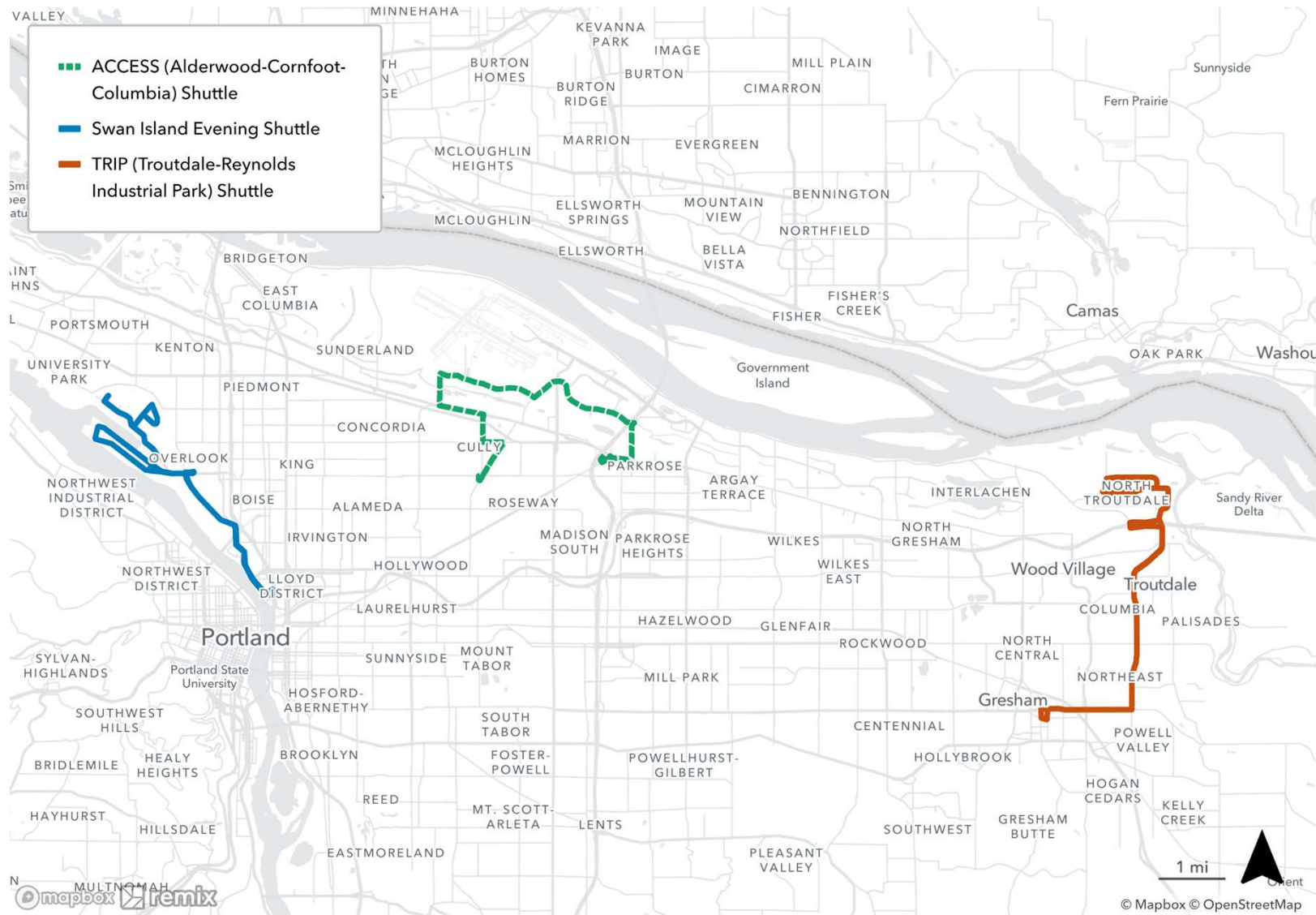

2021 Outreach - Overview

- Community Survey (English and Spanish)
 - 83 responses (4 in Spanish)
 - 35% identify as people of color
- Employer Survey
 - 27 responses
 - Number of employees: from 5 to 1224



Outreach - Community Survey Highlights

- 25% rode transit “most days” (post-3/2020)
- 55% work in the shuttle service area
- Shuttle would provide connections to:
 - Jobs (35%)
 - Grocery store (22%)
 - Community services (15%)
 - Medical Service (5%)



Outreach – Employer Survey Highlights

Difficulty recruiting/retaining employees due to transit/transportation issues?

None: 26%

Minor/rare: 30%

Moderate: 37%

Significant: 7%

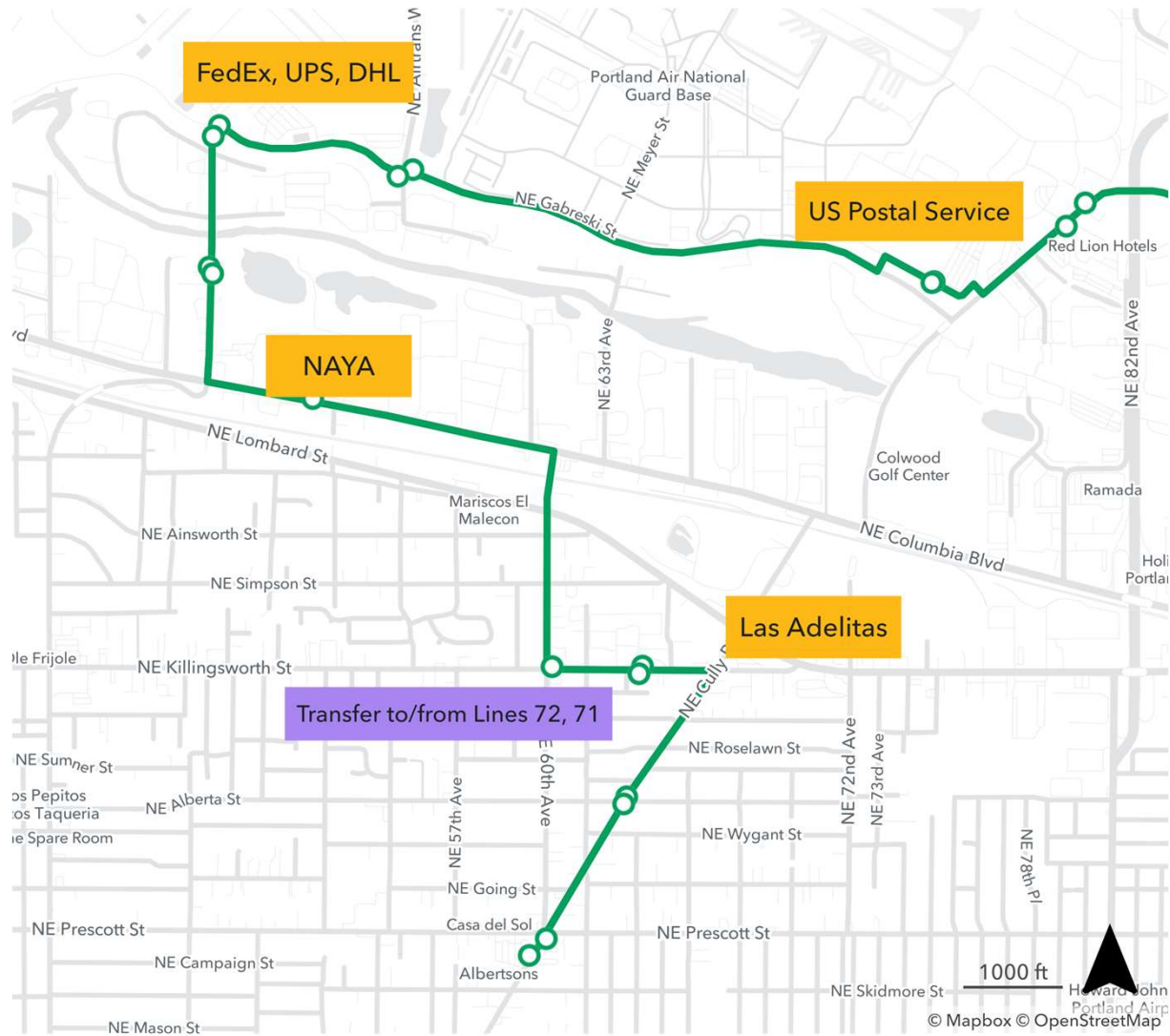




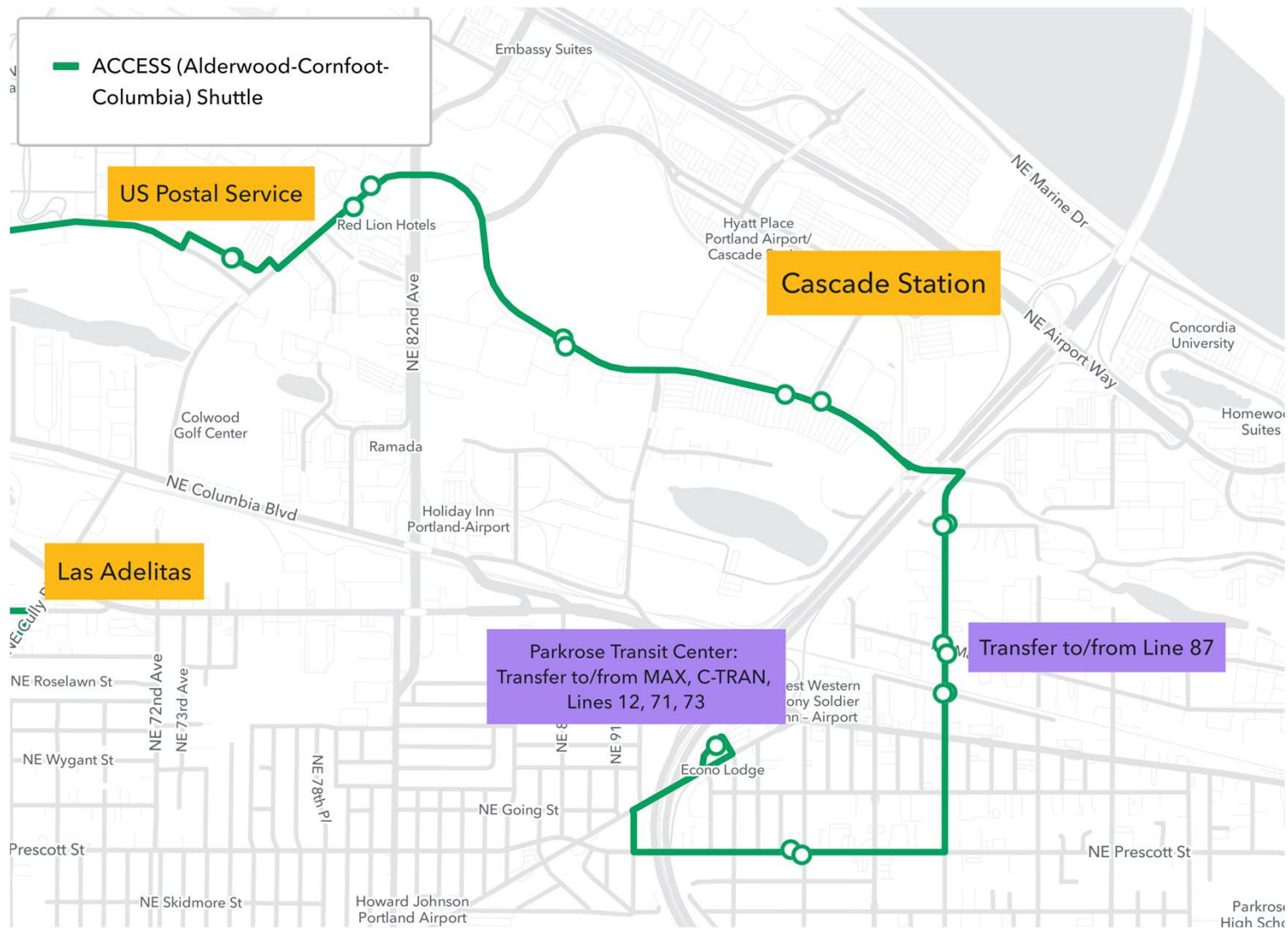
