
"p:ear works" creatively builds pathways for youth to end their homelessness and poverty by providing meaningful job training and employment opportunities

p:ear has provided over 320,000 hours of safe space and education, art and recreation programming.








Bikeworks by p:ear


- Recent new team member at Bikeworks as the Bicycle & Pedestrian Safety & Education Outreach Coordinator
