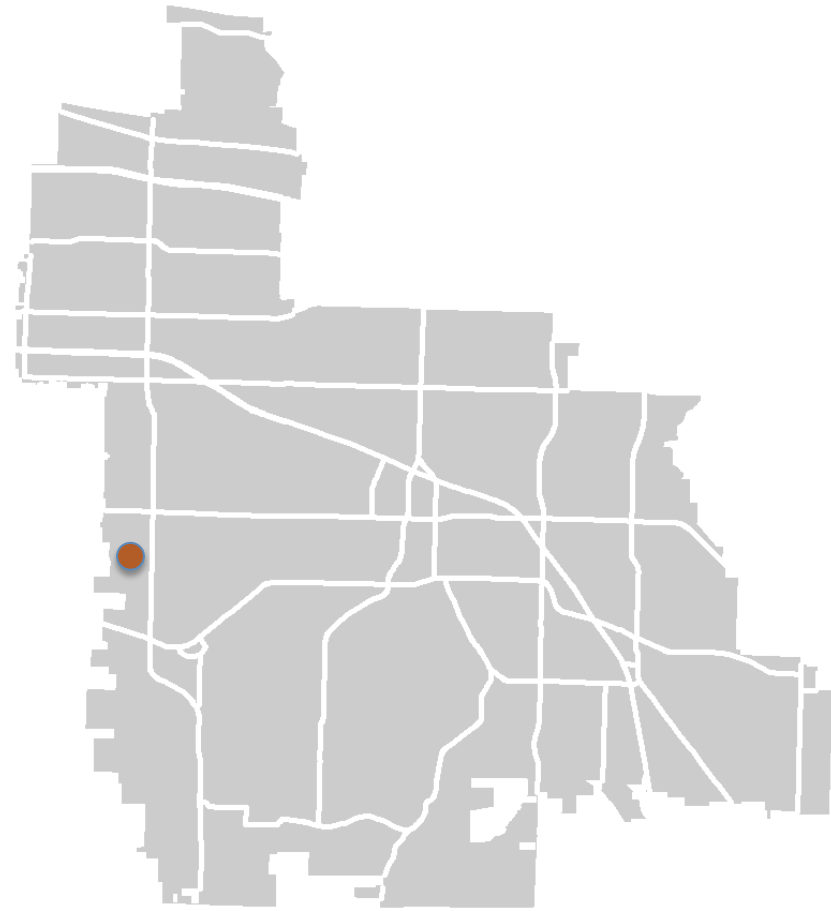

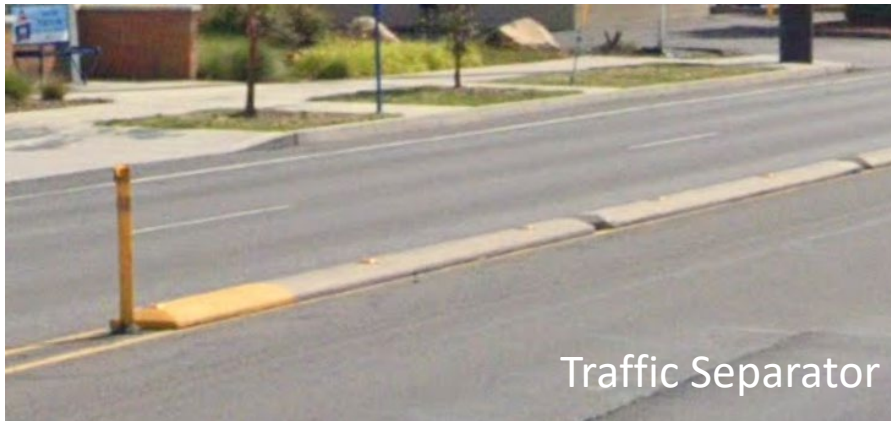

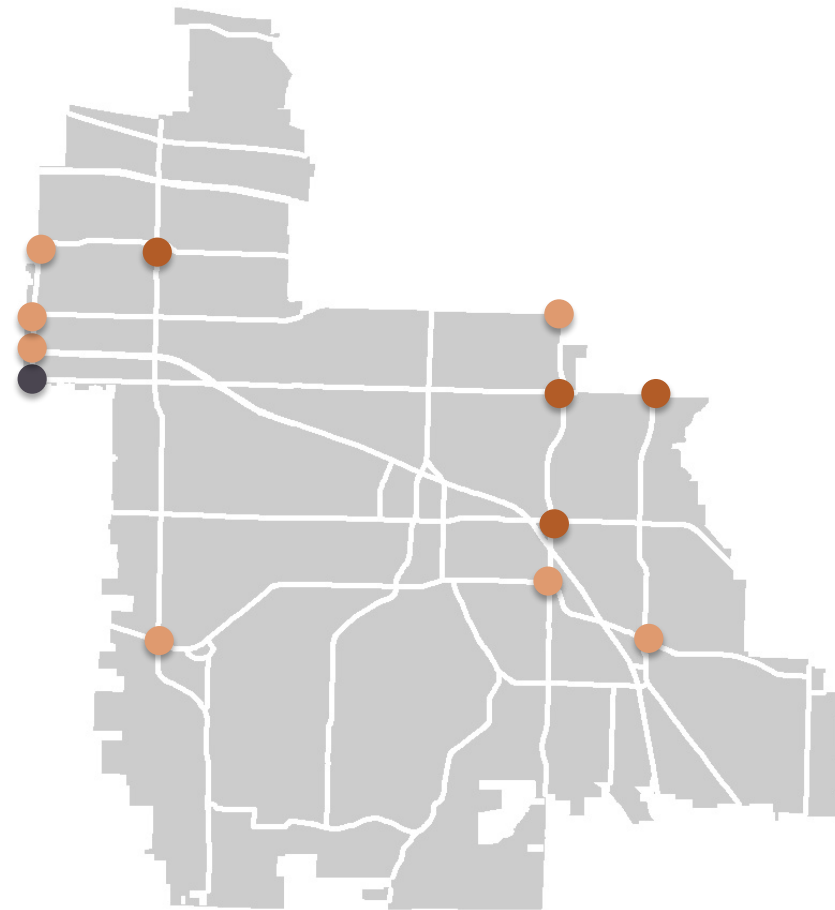

- Regional Flexible Funds grant

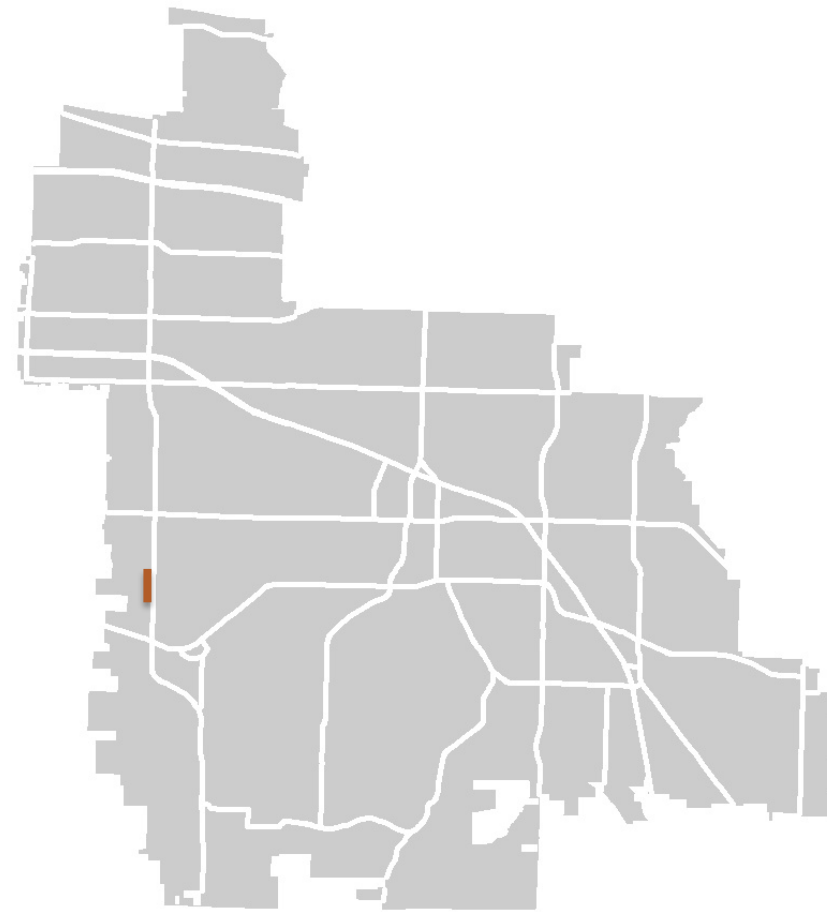


Wy'East Way Realignment
