- Shared scooters and bikes

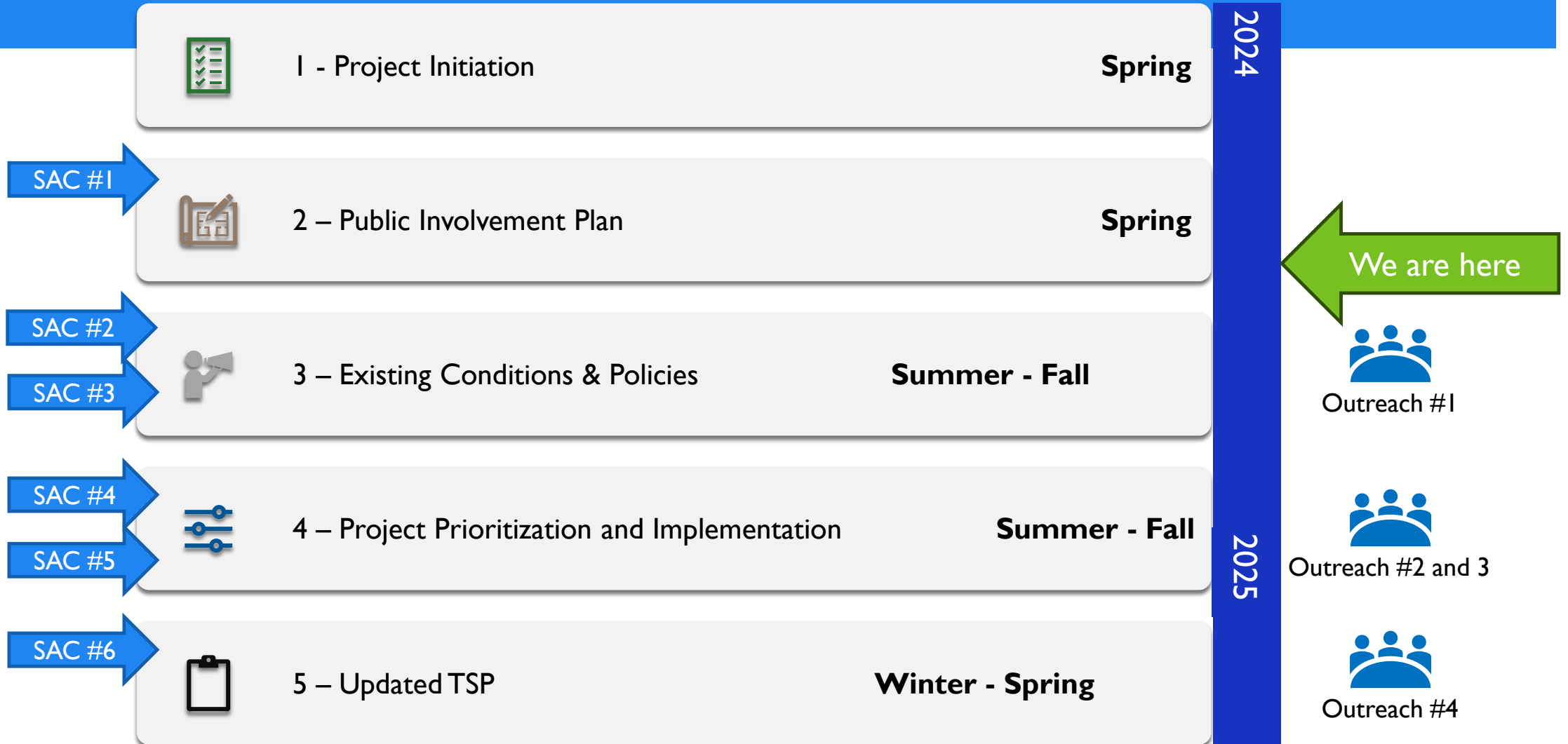

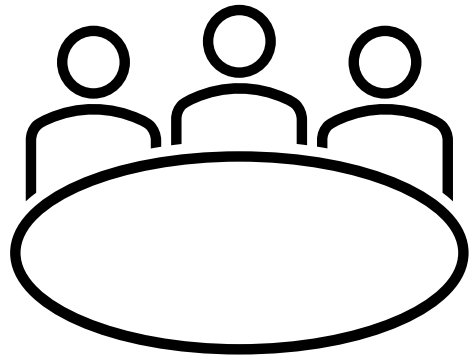
