Construction - Development

- NW corner of Halsey and 223rd - Halsey Crossing
 - A mixed use and multi-family development
 - Road widening to include bike lanes, curb and gutter, sidewalk and stormwater facility
- 21929 NE Halsey Street - Halsey Commons
 - A mixed use development
 - Curb, gutter, sidewalk and driveway
- 910 SW Halsey Street
 - A multi family housing unit
 - Road widening to include bike lanes, curb, gutter, sidewalk and stormwater facility



Construction - Capital

- Halsey and 240th/244th -
 - Pedestrian crossings include flashing crosswalk and improved ADA ramps and island
 - ADA ramps will need to be rebuilt and traffic impacts anticipated to all modes of travel
- Foster/Richey Culvert Replacement
 - Replaces a culvert in front of Pleasant Valley School on Foster, no roadway improvements
 - Traffic impact during summer season one lane closures and bikes/pedestrians in roadway along Foster



Construction - Capital

- Glisan Street - 223rd to 242nd
 - Paving and ADA Ramp improvements. Work done by the City of Gresham
- Larch Mountain Road Improvement
 - Paving of Larch Mountain Road from Milepost 7 to Milepost 14
 - Larch Mountain Road closed during construction, trail access will remain open
